

# 2023 Siskiyou Golden Fair LIVESTOCK - RABBITS

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

- The age in months or date of birth, breed and color must be stated on the entry form of each animal entered.
- All animals must be identified by a legible permanent ear tattoo or marking conforming to the entry form in the left ear.
- No duplicate ear markings will be accepted and all animals with duplicate ID will be disqualified.
- Animals will be shown in the order posted in the small animal barn.
- A judge may disqualify a rabbit from competition because of temporary or curable defects.

The Siskiyou Golden Fair provides an opportunity for Clubs, Chapters, Families or Individuals to enter one (1) backup market animal per exhibitor. If the family has one (1) shared backup animal total, **each exhibitor must enter the backup animal under their name in order for the animal to be eligible and pay the processing fee.** Each exhibitor that chooses to enter a backup animal will pay for a \$5.00 processing fee when entering. In the event that the animal is exhibited in the annual fair, a \$15.00 fee will be collected in the livestock office, a weight ticket will be issued and the animal will be entered in the exhibitor’s name that will be assigned the animal.

Backup animals are the only entries that can be moved across divisions and classes.

**JUNIOR CINCH SHOWMANSHIP**

Entry Fees:	No entry fee
Limit:	One (1) entry per exhibitor
Type of Judging:	American
Restrictions:	Open to Siskiyou, Shasta, Modoc, Lassen & Trinity counties

- Showmanship is MANDATORY for junior exhibitors entering market classes and must be entered with other livestock entries prior to the deadline.
- Only animals entered by a junior exhibitor in the junior department are eligible.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal and be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.
- The animal used for the overall species showmanship class must be the same animal that was used to gain entry into said class.
- All FFA and Grange member exhibitors must wear the official uniform of their organization while showing their animals.
- 4-H and Independent exhibitors are encouraged to wear the traditional 4-H uniform. New blue or black jeans may be substituted for the white jeans. A white collared shirt (short or long sleeved) must be worn.
- Small animal exhibitors must wear long sleeved white shirt.
- Hats or headgear of any kind (unless part of the official uniform) shall not be worn with official show uniforms.
- There will not be any cash premiums issued for showmanship.

**SMALL ANIMAL FASHION SHOW**

This is a fun show open to all junior small animal exhibitors at the Siskiyou Golden Fair. Small animals will be dressed in creative and safe fashions. Clothes/costumes may not contain glue or pins that could harm the animal. You may not shave, dye or glue the animal's nature fur or feathers. No piercings.

Exhibitor costumes are strongly encouraged, but not required. Clothes/costumes do not have to be handmade by the exhibitor; store bought costumes are okay.

1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> ribbons will be handed out in each class. The winner of each class will participate for Best of Show. Best of Show, Most Creative and Best Team (animal and exhibitor) awards will be handed out.
