- All entries in this class must have been home produced by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair. Items that have been previously shown at the Siskiyou Golden Fair are not eligible.
- Exhibits must be cleaned and pressed.
- There is to be NO GLITTER on any items.
- Quilt measurements are for the total perimeter of the quilts. Measure all four sides and add those numbers together to obtain the total perimeter measurement.
- All quilts MUST HAVE 4-inch sleeve (opening) attached to the back for display purposes.
- As many quilts as possible will be hung, but fair management reserves the right to not hang every quilt.

Hand Quilted quilts are quilted by hand, no machine quilt stitching.

Stationary Machine Quilted quilts are quilted with a stationary sewing machine that allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than the machine.

Moveable Machine Quilted quilts are quilted with a moveable quilting machine that allows the quilter to move the machine rather than the fabric.

Computer Aided Machine Quilted quilts are quilted with a computer aided moveable quilting machine where the quilter programs the computer and the moveable quilting machine stitches independently of the quilter.
