June 19th, 2025 General Meeting Minutes

**Membership:** There were 5 members in attendance.

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Darrin Mercier at 5:30 pm at Darrin Mercier's Law Office in Yreka.

**Secretary's Report:** Debbie Fogle moved to accept the May 2025 minutes seconded by Julie Mercier. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Jean Wood made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Debbie Fogle. Motion carried.

**Fair Report:** No Fair Report, Cliff is not available.

There will be no Chickens, Dairy cows or Turkeys at the Fair.

**Old Business:**

1. Status of Collections. All collections are done. Check cleared from Shane Oakley, small claims case has been vacated.
2. Fair Projects/Memorial Bench for Jim Scala. Darrin Mercier advised he did not know if the washrack pressure project had been completed yet. Debbie Fogle advised she is researching wood vs. metal for the Jim Scala memorial bench and will look into a plaque. Mireya Masson stated she would reach out to family members for photographs of Jim.
3. Show works software update. Jean Wood is working on the update and will leave the computers at the fair office if necessary.
4. Tax Return. AGT has taken JLAC as a client. '21 - '23 tax returns may need to be refiled and amended. They are working with the IRS to determine what the fine was for.
5. Buyers Packet. Jennifer Harrison will update dates and animals, we will maintain the same sale order. The board will look into doing a trifold buyer pamphlet for the June 2026 Fair. Board members will double check with 5 Marys and Starharvest about processing.
6. Credit Card Processing. Julie Mercier made a motion to maintain the 3% credit card processing fee, seconded by Jennifer Harrison. Motion carried. JLAC was

denied by Clover for the cc processing. Tri Counties bank advised they would be willing to help. Jennifer Harrison made a motion to open an account with Tri Counties and purchase their cc processing equipment, seconded by Jean Wood. Motion carried.

**New Business:**

1. Animal Loading/Truck Schedule. Debbie Fogle talked to Dan Freitas and he is still willing to set up and schedule the trucks and we will wait until we have an idea of the number of steers prior to setting that up. Jim Brown, the livestock superintendent will help with animal loading.
2. Auction Details. The board will need to order more shirts. Clinton Cash will see about getting a beverage trailer near the Auction. Saturday night will have Jim Scala memorial, and Sunday will have the scholarship recognition. Darrin received a quote from J. Martin for news advertisement prior to the auction and a buyer thank you after the auction. Debbie Fogle made a motion for a banner to be hung up at the auction thanking all of 2024 buyers, seconded by Julie Mercier. Motion carried. The auction trailer will need a restock of supplies, print cartridges, paper, duplicate paper, cardstock etc.
3. Event Insurance. Jennifer Harrison stated it would be \$180 per day. Julie Mercier made a motion to approve the payment for the event insurance, seconded by Debbie Fogle. Motion carried.
4. Hat Sponsorship. Debbie Fogle has reached out to Clayton Hansen and Evans Construction.
5. Shirt Inventory/ Status. Debbie Fogle will order a variety of shirts.
6. Photographer/Backdrops/Banners. JLAC will be redoing all of the banners for the 100 year anniversary. Jennifer Harrison received a quote from Lacy Ann Photography for \$3900 to do photographs. She will provide an assistant and make sure someone is there until all photos are printed and accounted for. Julie Mercier made a motion to proceed with her services, seconded by Mireya Masson. Motion carried.
7. Prop 12 Certs. Brand inspections and prop 12 certs will be required at weigh in.
8. Spring Bred Heifer Class for June Fair. There was general consensus to remove the spring bred heifer class for the 2026 June Fair due to the timing of the Fair.
9. Other. Matt Libby requested recognition of the Siskiyou Bred and Born winners in the parade of champions. No additional winners will be added to the parade of champions.
