

2026 Siskiyou Golden Fair

BEEF

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

Please see the Daily Schedule for deadlines and drop off dates and locations.

Pen requests need to be emailed to info@sisqfair.com no later than the entry deadline to be considered.

- Cattle must be halter broke to lead. Runaway cattle will be disqualified and removed from the grounds.
- Cattle must have a double night tie. One tie must be around the neck of the animal.
- All bulls 12 months and older must have a nose lead.
- Bred beef market heifers **MUST** be bred by March 24th. NO heifers allowed over 30 months of age.
- Bred Beef Heifers that calve after the preg check but before the fair and still be eligible.
- Bred beef heifers must have a second opinion pregnancy check if determined to be open or abnormal by the first exam.
- Horned, tipped or dehorned are permissible for breeding animals. Market animals must be dehorned, scurs are permissible. (Scur definition – incompletely developed, horn like growths that are loosely attached to the skin and not firmly anchored to the skull.)
- Bred market heifers are required to have four working quarters.
- Heifers that have unacceptable pelvis area, narrow or small, as determined by the veterinarian will be disqualified.
- California does not require cattle to be Brucellosis vaccinated at this time. It is still highly recommended that heifers entered and for sale receive the vaccination.

(9-18 years old as of January 1st)

Entry Fees:	\$20.00 per entry per lot
Limit:	Two (2) entries per exhibitor per lot
Type of Judging:	Danish
Restrictions:	Open to 10 th District residents
New Requirement:	All exhibitors entering a market animal MUST also enter a still exhibit to be eligible to participate in the Siskiyou Golden Fair!! And do not forget to sign up for Showmanship, it is mandatory also.

LOCAL BEEF SCORE CARD

Market Ready: Market beef projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice or Select+ quality grades. Market beef deemed Market Ready will be placed and may be sifted on confirmation by the official judge.

Not Market Ready: Market beef lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Beef projected to grade USDA Select- or lower regardless of conformation.
