It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to read and follow all State and Local Rules. Any infraction of these rules will result in the forfeiture of all premiums and possible removal from the fairgrounds.

Please see the Daily Schedule for deadlines and drop off dates and locations.

- State rules shall supersede all Horse Association rules. Rules and definitions for conducting each class as written in the USA Equestrian will apply, unless otherwise specified.
- Exhibitors cannot cross enter halter classes.
- Stalls will be available starting Friday of the Junior Horse Show and Friday of fair week for the Open Horse Show; fees must be paid with entries.
- Horses may be led to the arena gate, but riders must enter the arena without assistance. Non-compliance will result in disqualification in that class.
- Camping, with power, in the equestrian area is limited and will be on a first-come first served basis to out-of-county participants and at management's discretion.
