JUNIOR MARKET SWINE (9-18 years old as of January 1st)

Entry Fees:	\$20.00 per entry per lot
Type of Judging:	Danish
New Requirement:	All exhibitors entering a market animal MUST also enter a still exhibit to be eligible to participate in the Siskiyou Golden Fair!! And do not forget to sign up for Showmanship, it is mandatory also.

- Proposition 12 requires that all individuals bringing swine to the fair have a certification from a third party on file with the auction committee. This form is to be turned in at the scale at weigh in.

Class 1	Local bred and born market hogs only; MUST be purchased from a swine breeder in Siskiyou County. Verification must be provided by the exhibitor at check in at the livestock office. Exhibitor MUST enter the Market class to be eligible to enter the Bred & Born class.
