



## 2026 Siskiyou Golden Fair WHAT'S NEW & REMINDERS

The Exhibitor Handbook/Class Listings & Rules will only be on the website. It will be separated in sections and labeled for easier location of information. Be sure to read ALL rules and regulations before entering.

### WHAT'S NEW?

All market animal and vocational education exhibitors **MUST** enter a still exhibit AND sign up for "barn duty" to participate at the Siskiyou Golden Fair

If you are bringing a market animal AND a vocational education project you only need to do ONE still exhibit

Market animals deemed not market ready, must leave the grounds immediately

Complimentary shavings (1 bag) per junior livestock market exhibitors, receive at check-in

Junior Horse Show will be held on Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> – before the fair

### REMINDERS!

Be sure to check the **DAILY SCHEDULE** for deadlines and drop off locations.

Parent passes **MUST** be purchased online through the entry program. Two passes per family of a junior livestock exhibitor may be purchased in advance at a discount. Passes **WILL NOT** be sold onsite.

If you are bringing in more than 20 items on receiving day, please arrive **BEFORE 3:00 PM** so there is plenty of time to get them all checked in.

Cash Premiums for Still Exhibits will be available in the office after Thursday of fair at 3:00 PM until 20 working days after the fair ends. Be sure to pick up your winnings!!

Livestock premium checks will be available on Sunday at the Livestock Office and then the fair office starting Monday.

Open Horse Show premiums will be mailed.

All premiums **NOT** picked up within 20 days after the fair will be considered a donation to the 10<sup>th</sup> DAA.

Auction Thank You cards **MUST** be turned into the fair office no later than August 15<sup>th</sup> or the seller will have to request their check from the Junior Livestock Auction Committee once meetings resume.
