Dick is recognized for his saving of numerous homes, countless medical aides, and his fundraising via the annual barbeque and auction. Dick was recognized with the 2013 Yreka FFA Honorary member award for all he had done for the FFA Chapter.

Dick has been, and continues to be, an integral part of our community; willing to aid any and everyone. He has always gone above and beyond for his community. Today, he continues his support and offers his time to the community through his involvement in the Mayten Fire Department as board president, supporting his grand and great grandchildren with their livestock interests as well as 4-H and FFA ventures.
