- 3) Two Letters of Recommendation
- 4) High School Transcript

THE ABOVE ITEMS MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY AS A **SINGLE PDF ATTACHMENT**. APPLICATION FORM CAN BE TYPED IN ACROBAT READER. IF HANDWRITTEN, MUST BE LEGIBLE. Be sure to review all items thoroughly before submitting your application. Application packet must be received no later than Tuesday, October 18, 2022. **Please note: incomplete or unsigned packets will be disqualified.**

To be eligible, the student must have completed his/her junior year in high school, be a permanent resident of Florida and reside in one of the following counties: Broward, Hendry, Martin, Okeechobee or Palm Beach.

## SCHOLARSHIP FACT SHEET

The South Florida Fair Scholarship program's purpose is to encourage young people to pursue a higher education and/or trade. These scholarships will be paid as described in each category listed below. The South Florida Fair will award the following scholarships to qualified applicants selected by the Scholarship Committee. The Committee has the right to amend scholarship amounts as it deems necessary. Scholarships must be used within a 5-year period from date of award or will be forfeited back to the South Florida Fair.

Amount of Scholarship	Number Awarded	Terms of Scholarship Award
Ranging from \$1,000 to \$6,000	Minimum of 15	For a student displaying Academic Excellence. Scholarships ranging from \$1,000 - \$3,000 will be paid in a lump sum to the educational institution; scholarships over \$3,000 will be paid annually over a 4 year period.
\$1,000 Each	2	For a student displaying Academic Excellence. Paid in full the first year to the educational institution. No renewal. <b>APPLICANT MUST BE PURSUING A DEGREE IN THE FIELD OF AGRICULTURE.</b> <b><i>Sponsored by Palm Beach County Farm Bureau &amp; Western Palm Beach County Farm Bureau</i></b>
\$4,000	1	Paid in increments of \$1,000 per year for a period of four years to the educational institution. For a student in financial need and in good academic standing. <b><i>Sponsored by the Avellana Family Scholarship</i></b>
\$2,000	1	For a student displaying Academic Excellence. <b><i>The William H. Pruitt Scholarship</i></b>
\$2,500	1	For a student pursuing a degree in Agricultural Studies. <b><i>The Congressman Mark Foley Scholarship for Agricultural Studies</i></b>

### Criteria:

1. The applicant must have completed their junior year in high school, be a permanent resident of Florida, and reside in one of the following counties: Broward, Hendry, Martin, Okeechobee or Palm Beach.
2. Additional credit will be given if the applicant is, or has been, a participant in the South Florida Fair's activities. Activities may consist of judging events, exhibits, or any other activity acceptable to the Scholarship Committee.
3. Membership in 4-H or FFA is NOT required.
4. The awards will be presented during the annual South Florida Fair in January.
5. The scholarship must be used at, and must be paid to, an accredited college, university, or trade school. It will not be paid to the applicant.
6. The selection committee requires a personal interview with the applicant.
7. Advertising and promotional agencies, sponsors, Trustees, Directors, staff of the South Florida Fair and their immediate family members, and/or those living in the same household, are ineligible to apply.
8. An essay is required. Those who do not complete the essay will not be eligible for a scholarship. "Describe something about which you are passionate. How did you learn more about it and what was it that motivated you to pursue it?" (200 words or less).
9. Two letters of recommendation are required.
10. High School Transcript is required.
