

St. Paul Rodeo Frequently Asked Questions

TICKET PRICES, SECURITY POLICIES, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND FULL SCHEDULE INCLUDED AT THE END OF THIS DOCUMENT

TICKETS

Q. Where is the ticket office?

A. 20025 4th Street. Under Section A on the east side of the arena.

<u>Prices:</u> *All seats reserved. All Children age 2 & over need a ticket! (See attached price sheet)

Q. Are tickets okay on your phone?

A. YES - tickets just need to be scan-able. Although, it is preferred that tickets are printed out.

Sell Out Performance

Q. What else can we do?

A. Carnival, Vendors, Wild West Art Show, Tack Room. Fireworks after the show. Buy tickets for the next performance.

ANIMALS

Q. Are animals allowed?

A. Only certified service animals on leash are allowed in the arena seating area - if space allows, may need to purchase additional seat; No pets.

If outside arena, all animals must be on a leash around grounds.

STADIUM OPENING AND POLICIES /ARRIVAL TIME

Q. What time do gates to the Arena open?

A. 1 hour prior to show. 6:30pm for the 7:30pm shows and 12:30 for the 1:30pm show.

Q. What time should I arrive?

A. Our ticket office is open at 11:00am to 9:00pm.

Suggest arriving to grounds about 2 hours prior to rodeo to allow time to park and get into arena.

<u>Carnival, and Vendors open</u> at 3:00 p.m. on July 2, 1:00 p.m. on July 3 & 5, 11:00 a.m. on July 4 and 1:00 p.m. on July 6.

Wild West Art Show at 3:00pm. on July 2,3,and 5. 11:00 a.m. on July 4 and 1:00 p.m. on July 6 Tack Room Saloon opens at 4:00 p.m. on July 2, 3 & 5. Noon on July 4 and 3:00 p.m. on July 6

O. Can I take food or drinks into the arena?

A. Food is ok. Water is ok if in sealed container. No coolers. No alcohol. Alcohol is for sale under the stands, along with additional food & drinks. The St. Paul High School Booster Club has food concessions all throughout the stadium.

Q. Where is the VIP entrance?

Q. Gold Spur entrance is at section D/E. Company Corral is by section G gate, go up the outside staircase north of the ticket office. The entrance to the VIP DECK is through the Tack Room.

Q. Can I bring my camera into the stadium?

A. Cell phone cameras and still camera with a lens less than 3 inches long can be brought into the stadium to take photos for PERSONAL USE ONLY. The St. Paul Rodeo is sanctioned by the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association and that organization owns the rights to all videos and photos therefore only member photographers, the St. Paul Rodeo or the PRCA are allowed to sell photos or use them for any commercial purposes. Those with cameras with lenses over 3 inches must return those to their car or proceed to the rodeo house to discuss a camera pass.

ATM

Q. Where are the ATM's?

A. By ticket office, by section D&E, and by the Jaycees beer garden.

Changing Tables/ Family Tent

Q. Where are the changing tables, family tent?

A. Changing tables are in Family Tent located in carnival area near the Jaycees Beer Garden.

FIREWORKS

Q. Where is best place to view?

A. Outside of arena on south side in parking lot area. Or if sitting in arena, sections F & G are uncovered and best to view from your seat.

Q. What time do they start?

A. When the rodeo performance ends, usually around 9:45 or 10 pm

BEER TOKENS/ID CHECK

Q. Do I have to buy tokens to buy beer?

A. Yes. Beer sales will be by token this year – tokens are available adjacent to the beer stands in Sections A/B, D, F & G and in the Tack Room Saloon. The Ticket office will also have tokens available for sale. All guests who look under 30 years old will be required to get their ID's verified and get a wrist band when purchasing tokens or entering the Tack Room. The main stage tent will take tokens or credit cards for beer purchase and will be verifying ID's also.

Q. Do I have to show my ID to purchase alcohol?

A. All guests should be prepared to show their ID if a server asks, the policy for the rodeo is to use the ID verification machines and check ID's for those who look under 30 years of age when purchasing tokens and/or when being served at the beer stands, Main Stage Tent or Tack Room Saloon. After ID verification guests will receive a plastic band verifying them 21 and over that can be left on the entire event and they will not need to stand in line to get the ID verified unless they lose the wrist band. Even with a wrist band patrons may be asked to show their ID when purchasing alcohol.

CARNIVAL

Q. What is the cost of a wrist band?

A. Up to the end of day on July 1, wrist bands are \$25 at Rodeo Ticket Office or online.

The carnival wristband is a voucher that is purchased from us for \$25. It is good to be redeemed for any one day, July 2-6. On the day it is redeemed at the Davis Shows booth, it is only good that one day. Starting July 2 they are \$30 purchased at Davis Shows ticket booth.

Q. Are wrist bands good on July 4th during discounted Rides?

A. Yes, they are good all day.

Q. What is the discounted price of rides on July 4?

A. All rides are \$2 from 11:00am to 3:00pm.

Q. What is the regular cost of a ride ticket, and how many tickets per ride?

A. Cost is \$1.25 per ticket and most rides take 3 to 4 tickets, you can buy a book of 24 tickets for \$24.

Q. Where do you exchange ride Vouchers for Wrist band?

A. All ride Vouchers are exchanged at the Main Davis Shows carnival ticket booth by the Bull Pen.

DAVIS SHOWS (Carnival Operator)

Q. How do I reach Davis Shows?

A. Pat Davis ph. is 503-539-4526, or Jessy 503-656-0225.

O. How old do you need to be to work for Davis shows?

A. 18 years old.

FIRST AID, LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

O Where is the first aid station?

A. It is a white tent across from the Ticket Office.

Q. Is there an AED onsite?

A. Yes. In the art show tent at the front desk

Q. What do I do in case of an emergency?

Emergency plan is attached at the end of this document.

Marion County Sheriff

Q. Where is the Marion County Command Unit?

A. The Command Unit is located at the corner of 2nd and Park.

Q. Where are fire extinguishers?

A. See the Emergency Map. Art show tent, Main Stage Tent, Bull Pen, Ticket office, Gate D/E, Tack Room, Rodeo House, Entry Office

Q. Do you have any Wheelchairs or Scooters to Rent?

A. No

HOSPITALITY TENT *

Q. Hours?

A. 5:30-8pm for all evening shows.

11:30am-2pm on the day of the 4th

O. Location?

A. It is on the south side of the arena. Large, white tent with red & white striped roof.

*Only Members, VIP's, Contestants & Sponsors are allowed. They must have a hospitality pass.

LOST

Q. Where is the Lost and Found?

A. Lost items may be found at the ticket office.

Q. Where can I find my lost child?

A. Lost children can be found at the ticket office.

MEDIA

Q. How do I get a press pass?

A. All press must have a valid pass & check in at the Rodeo House on Malo Avenue located on the south side of the arena. It is the large two story gray house across from the Art Show Tent. Valid passes must be visible at all times. Only journalists with valid assignments will be granted press passes due to the limited space available.

PROGRAMS

Q. Where can I purchase SPR Rodeo Program?

A. Program books can be purchased 1 hour prior to show, sold at each gate for \$5. Day Sheets are \$2.

SOUVENIRS AND COLLECTIBLES

Q. Where can I purchase St. Paul Rodeo merchandise.

A. The souvenir booths are across the parking lot from the ticket office and by D& E gate, and in tent by F gate. The Wild West Art Show has posters, jewelry, license plate frames and other commemorative items available for sale at the front desk.

O. Are there seat cushions for sale?

A. No

RODEO

Q. What is the order of the rodeo and time frame? 7:30pm-10/10:30pm

- Bareback Riding
- Steer Wrestling
- Bull Riding
- Tie-Down Roping
- Junior Bull Riding
- Mid-Show Entertainment
- Jackpot Wild Cow Milking
- Saddle Bronc Riding

Q. Do the daily riders change?

A. Yes, we will not know the line-up until the contestants arrive because they might not show up.

Q. When is the championship round?

A. St. Paul does not have a "short go" but the champions will be determined during the final performance.

MAIN STAGE TENT

Q. Where is the "main" stage? What is available in that area?

- o Adjacent to River Road next to the Art Show Tent and West of the Arena wall
- Ocost to get in? Free on 3rd and 6th guests can bring in carnival food and eat
- o BBQ Cookoff at 11 am on July 4
- o Coke products, water, Coors, Coors light and craft beers available for sale

PARADE

O. What time is the Parade?

A. July 4th at 10am but roads close at 9:30am.

Q. Who is the grand marshal for the parade?

A. The 2019 grand marshal is the state champion St. Paul high school girls' volleyball and basketball teams.

O. What is the route?

A. HS, Main, Malo, 4th, Church, 2nd, Across FFA field... Picture of the parade route can be viewed on the website.

Q. List of events for families on the 4th and how long activities last

A. Parade at 10:00 a.m., Pony rides and rodeo queen autographs at noon in the warm up arena. BBQ Cookoff at 11:00 a.m. Main Stage Tent, discounted Carnival starting at 11:00 a.m. in the City Park.

CONTESTANTS AND COURTS

Q. How do you enter the cow milking contest?

A. Entry office – small white building in parking lot south of the grandstands.

Q. Where do rodeo contestants sign up?

A. Entry office, as a PRCA rodeo all entries are done ahead of time with the exception of walk up replacements as per PRCA rules. No local entries. With valid PRCA card, companion rodeo tickets are available but only one per contestant.

Q. Where do Visiting Rodeo Courts sign up?

A. If riding in grand entry of performance, check in with Jennifer Tickner inside arena near flag pole at least 30 minutes prior to start. Only court members allowed in the paddock area – no helpers allowed. If court members cannot handle their horses by themselves it would not be safe to ride in the grand entry.

Court Luncheon – is after parade on July 4 in paddock area on Gold Spur deck.

St. Paul Rodeo Court

Q. How do I try out for 2020 St. Paul Rodeo Court?

Go to <u>www.stpaulrodeo.com</u> and download and fill out an application. Tryouts are October 13th at the Fairgrounds in McMinnville. Applications are also available at the Information Booth in front of the main stage tent.

PARKING AND TRAFFIC

Q. Where is the VIP parking?

- A. General parking lot, they will direct you
- Q. Where do I park?
- A. The Rodeo association has a lot adjacent to the stadium that will fill up quick, cost \$10.

There is a lot just across River Road for \$10, Parking at the High School for \$10 and in town for free. Be aware that no traffic will be allowed in town until after pedestrians clear out. Rodeo lot and lot across the street will be directed SOUTH (detours and signs in place to guide you) and High School lot will be directed NORTH. AVOID TOWN until at least one hour after performance

CAMPING (Dry camping no hookup)

Q. How do you camp or reserve your spot?

- o How do you reserve a spot? Online
- o \$200 for week
- o Need a camper or trailer, no tents. No additional vehicles allowed on camp site.

MISCELLANEOUS

O. What is the time and entertainment and cost of the Jaycees Beer Garden?

A. Cover charge of \$10 at 9pm every night and live entertainment after the rodeo. Tuesday, July 2nd, 2019 no live entertainment and no cover charge. Opens at 4:30pm every night, except on July 4th which opens at 11am. FULL SCHEDULE ATTACHED

Q. Who do we call if the honey bucket needs attention? How often are they cleaned?

- **A.** They are cleaned every performance and please report it at the ticket office.
- Q. Where are the smoking areas?
- A. There is no smoking allowed on the rodeo grounds. Please proceed to parking lot or off of the rodeo grounds to smoke.

Q. Do you have a clean water fill station?

A. No, most vendors have water for sale.

ALL OTHER ITEMS AT THE MANAGEMENTS DISCRETION CAMERAS

PROFESSIONAL VIDEO OR STILL CAMERAS WITH LONG LENSES (OVER 3 INCHES) NOT ALLOWED IN STADIUM EXCEPT BY CREDENTIALED MEDIA.

By entering the St. Paul Rodeo Grounds you are agreeing to abide by these policies.

St. Paul Rodeo Emergency Procedures

<u>Acute</u> – suspected cardiac arrest, stroke, traumatic injury

- If during a rodeo performance, Find closest First Responders or call 503-633-4357 (Fire, Paramedic see locations marked by arrows on map on reverse) send someone to alert First Responders of the situation (either of these options provides more timely response than 911 as First Responders will be on rodeo grounds during rodeo performance and this local number reaches them directly).
 If alone and/or unable to send someone, stay with victim and Call the local number (503-633-4357) or 911
- Law enforcement officers can notify First Responders
- If NOT during rodeo performance, Call 911
- Information to provide First Responders or 911 Dispatch:
 - Location of victim
 - Estimated age & gender of victim
 - Brief description of what is happening
 - If a CPR certified person available at the scene, initiate CPR protocol if indicated while waiting for First Responders arrive.
 - Clear area around victim for Responders to provide aid.

Non-Acute - laceration, minor injuries


 Send or escort (if you are able to leave your post) victim to First Aid tent outside the main ticket office (Green arrow on map)

Fire

- Alert First Responders closest to location (see map)
- Provide accurate location of fire
- Find fire extinguisher (see red dots on map)
- If fire spreads, ushers and security will help direct people
- If no dangerous animals in arena, security will open gates into the arena to provide evacuation route if indicated.
- Be vigilant confirm no smoking/ no vaping

Other Emergencies - Earthquake, Terrorist Attack, Active Shooter, Collapse

- There is a plan in place with Emergency Providers (Police, Fire, Medical, Security)
- An Emergency Operation Center would be established away from the center of the event (Fire Department, Parochial School, High School)
- It is a unified command center, communication hub
- Concern would be potential grid lock from visitors rushing to leave the arena, blocking Emergency Services.
