Our members are the heart of our rodeo and we are very grateful for the hard work and dedication required each year to produce the Nation's Greatest 4th of July Rodeo and related events. MDC = St. Paul Rodeo Membership Development Committee

Membership Tiers: 1) New Member, 2) Active Member, 3) Honorary Member and 4) Associate Member

New Members

Requirements of New Members:

- Must be 21 years of age (Associate Membership offered for under 21)
- All **New** Members must work a minimum of three (3) shifts per year during rodeo week, for a period of three (3) years in one or more of the following areas: 1) Gates, 2) Usher, 3) Souvenir Booth, 4) Parking or a minimum of two (2) shifts in the Ticket Office.
 - New Members should contact the chairman of the committee they would like to work to get their shifts scheduled.
- All **New** Members are required to work as a server the first year for the annual Trail Ride Breakfast, held the first weekend in June.
- All New Members are required to work the SPR Annual Work Party in some capacity. The
 Annual Work Party is typically held the Saturday before Father's Day. By working at this
 event, you will be invited to the Members Only Steak Feed held the same evening. Failure to
 report for the Annual Work Party will revoke your invitation to the Members Only Steak
 Feed. Entry to the Members Only Steak Feed can be granted to those who are unable to
 attend the Annual Work Party but have volunteered their time during the weekly
 Wednesday work parties, at the discretion of the Maintenance Chair.
- All **New** Members are required to be on call, and available to work if needed, at the Annual Hall of Fame BBQ for a period of up to two (2) years.
- All New Members are required to work the first three (3) years at the annual Thank You
 Party Fish Feed. The Thank You Party Committee is made up of the BOD, their spouses, and
 all New Members for the current and prior two years.
- Once the commitment of the New Member has been met as outlined above, New Members will convert to Active Member status.
- If an **New** Member is unable to meet their volunteer requirements as outlined above, it is the obligation of the Member to inform the General Manager **in writing** at manager@stpaulrodeo.com explaining the circumstances.
- Failure of any **New** Member to fulfill their membership obligations as outlined above may result in either a possible revocation of membership from the St. Paul Rodeo Association.
- The BOD will make the final decision on status of any membership.

Benefits of New Membership:

New Member in good standing will receive:

- Each Member will receive two (2) tickets to one (1) rodeo performance.
- One (1) official parking sticker for rodeo week.
- One (1) hospitality tent voucher (good for one meal) for each shift worked, for up to a total of three (3) vouchers per Member.
- One (1) vote on all matters that come before the annual All Member meeting each year. Active Members and New Members are the electing body for the SPR Board of Directors.
- Attendance at the Annual All Member Meeting, Steak Feed and Fish Feed Thank You Party.

Active Members

Requirements of Active Membership:

- All Active Members must work a minimum of three (3) shifts per year during rodeo week.
 - If Active Members currently serve on the staff of a specific committee, and have done so on a regular basis for a period of two (2) or more years, that member will remain on said staff – as long as it is the desire of both the Committee Chair and the Member.
 - All members are welcome to explore any and all opportunity within the volunteer organization, keeping in mind that some committee additions require an invitation from a Director to join, or the member may continue serving on these initial committees listed above, and are welcome to work as many shifts as they desire once they meet their membership requirements.
- All **Active** Members are required to work the annual Trail Ride Breakfast, held the first weekend in June, every other year.
- All Active Members are required to work the SPR Annual Work Party in some capacity. The
 Annual Work Party is typically held the Saturday before Father's Day. By working at this
 event, you will be invited to the Members Only Steak Feed held the same evening. Failure to
 report for the Annual Work Party will revoke your invitation to the Members Only Steak
 Feed.
 - Entry to the Members Only Steak Feed can be granted to those who are unable to attend the Annual Work Party but have volunteered their time during the weekly Wednesday work parties, at the discretion of the Maintenance Chair.
 - All Active Members are required to work on at least one (1) social event throughout the year. These events consist of: All Member Meeting & Prime Rib Dinner, Queen & Court Coronation, Steak Feed and Thank You Party Fish Feed.
- If an Active Member is unable to meet their volunteer requirements as outlined above, it is
 the obligation of the Member to inform the General Manager in writing at
 manager@stpaulrodeo.com and ask for a leave of absence, move to associate or
 resignation.
- Failure of an **Active** Member to fulfill their membership obligations as outlined above may result in either a possible revocation of membership from the St. Paul Rodeo Association.
- The BOD will make the final decision on status of any membership.

Benefits Active Membership:

Active Members in good standing will receive:

- Two (2) tickets to one (1) rodeo performance.
- One (1) official parking sticker for rodeo week.
- One (1) hospitality tent voucher (good for one meal) for each shift worked by a Member, for up to a total of three (3) vouchers per Member. Vouchers will be available at the ticket office.
- One (1) vote on all matters that come before the annual All Member meeting each year. Active Members and New Members are the electing body for the SPR Board of Directors.
- Attendance at the Annual All Member Meeting, Steak Feed and Thank You Party Fish Feed.

Associate Members

The **Associate** Membership is for those who do not want to or cannot fully commit to an Active Membership, but still wish to be part of the Association and volunteer their time. An **Associate** Membership will also encompass those Active Members who neglect to fulfill their yearly obligations as described. This tier provides a gateway for youth to reach Active Member Status by the time they reach 21 years of age.

Requirements of Associate Membership:

- Associate Members must work a minimum of two (2) shifts during rodeo week.
 - Associate members should contact the chairman of the committee in which they wish to work to get assignments.
- Associate Members are not required to work at the SPR Annual Work Party but if they do choose to work, they may receive an invitation to the *Members Only* Steak Feed that evening.
- Associate Members are not entitled to receive tickets to a rodeo performance.
- **Associate** Members do not have voting rights and are therefore not eligible to attend the All Member Meeting & Prime Rib Dinner.
- Failure to meet any of the **Associate** Member obligations described above will result in potential revocation of membership from the SPRA organization.

Benefits of Associate Membership

Associate Members in good standing will receive:

- One (1) official parking sticker for the entire event, if working a minimum of two (2) shifts, and one (1) hospitality tent meal voucher for each shift worked for up to a total of two (2) total vouchers during rodeo week. Vouchers can be obtained through the ticket office.
 - If an Associate Member works more than their required two (2) shift minimum, they would be eligible for an additional hospitality tent meal voucher, for a maximum of three (3).
- **Associate** Members working a minimum of two (2) shifts will be eligible and invited to attend the Thank You Party in August.

Honorary Membership

- Members age 65 or over who have served fifteen (15) years or more as an Active Member, may choose to move to Honorary Member status by making a written request to General Manager at manager@stpaulrodeo.com. The Board of Directors will approve all changes in membership.
- Honorary Members maintain <u>ALL</u> benefits of an Active Member, but are not required to work rodeo week, on social events and/or for the trail ride breakfast but *may do so at* their desire.
- Many Honorary Members continue to work on a variety of committees by their own choice, and this is strongly welcomed and encouraged by the SPR Association.
