St. Paul, Ore. (August 3, 2020) – Hold on to your horses! Tickets go on sale August 14 for the 2021 St. Paul (Ore.) Rodeo!

After missing the 2020 rodeo due to COVID-19, the rodeo board and membership are ready to host a rodeo next year, said Cindy Schonholtz, general manager for the St. Paul Rodeo. “We are optimistic for a terrific 2021 rodeo,” she said. “We all missed gathering and celebrating our great country over the Fourth of July and we can’t wait till we can do it again!”

Fans are also looking forward to continuing the St. Paul Rodeo tradition next year, Schonholtz said, and have been asking for the ticket on-sale date for the 2021 event. “We’ve fielded lots of questions about next year’s rodeo and tickets for it.”

During the hiatus, the rodeo board and volunteers have been busy with facility improvements. The biggest project the rodeo has been working on is lighting. New lights in the stadium, park and rodeo grounds will make fans’ experience more enjoyable. Other projects the committee has been working on include new fencing on the south portion of the rodeo grounds and painting work.

Tickets go on sale August 14 online at [www.StPaulRodeo.com](http://www.StPaulRodeo.com). Rodeo seating is reserved, so purchasing tickets now to get the best seats is encouraged. Tickets range in price from \$16 to \$26 (plus a convenience fee.)

The rodeo is a fundraiser for many service and youth organizations around the area; it is produced by nearly one hundred percent volunteer labor.
