

In 2004 my husband, Glen Glancy, built a gingerbread replica of the ice Palace. It was originally displayed in the lobby of Lakeview Commons in Maplewood but was carefully transferred to The Landmark Center during the carnival. It was there that Glen was knighted by King Boreas. The gingerbread castle took 120 hours to complete. 40 lbs of confectioner's sugar, dozens of egg whites and 8 industrial-sized pans of scratch-baked gingerbread.
