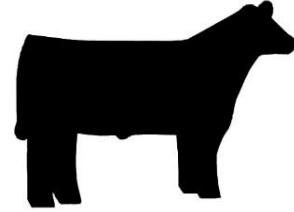


Stanislaus Cattleman's Beef Supporters Scholarship

2026 SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarships of varied amounts will be given to active Stanislaus County Beef enthusiasts



REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must be a graduating Senior (class of 2026) attending college or a vocational school in the fall of 2026.
2. Applicants must be a 2026 Stanislaus County Fair Exhibitor.
3. Applications for the 2026 Stanislaus Cattleman's Beef Supporter's Scholarship will be due to the Beef Clerk in the Stanislaus County Fair Livestock Office by Wednesday, July 15th by 3:00p.m.
4. Applications need to be accompanied by:
 - a. Resume
 - b. One Current Letter of Recommendation
 - c. Official Sealed Transcript or Unofficial Transcript for Grades 9-12.
5. Each applicant will need to put up an educational display at or by their stalling area that will need to be displayed from Tuesday, July 14th through Friday, July 17th.
6. Applicants will be required to go through an interview on the morning of Friday July 17th. Applicants interviewing in both Outstanding Exhibitor and Scholarship interviews will be accommodated accordingly.
7. If awarded a scholarship, please provide proof of enrollment when available.
