SEPTEMBER 24 – OCTOBER 3, 2021

### YOUTH LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

- One (1) – Five (5) Day Admission wristband free with a minimum of an \$8.00 entry fee, this includes large and small animals.
- Exhibitors entering more than one (1) youth livestock department and an open class department will receive a wristband; no passes will be issued. Youth exhibitors entering in more than one department first half will be reviewed for pass allotments.
- One (1) Infield Parking Pass, for exhibiting half, per family, regardless of how many departments you are entering.....Free
- If more parking credentials are needed, they must be purchased.
- **Parent Discount Passes – First Half ONLY.** Parents may purchase a maximum of ten (10) passes at \$8.00 each; **only ten (10) passes may be purchased for youth exhibitor(s) per household, regardless of how many households are involved.** A Parent Discount Pass form is located on website at and must be submitted with payment on or before September 23<sup>rd</sup>. This offer will not stand as of September 24<sup>th</sup>. This is for youth livestock exhibitors only.
- **Exhibitor Restock Permit – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> half.** A temporary parking pass is available for parking behind the barns between the hours of 6:00am to 10:00am for unloading hay, straw, equipment etc. All vehicles must be removed from inside the grounds, to a parking area by 10:00am or they will be towed away. Please indicate on the discount passes form if you wish a permit. The permit is good only for the driver's admittance. Each passenger in the vehicle must have an admission pass.

### POULTRY AT THE CENTRAL WASHINGTON STATE FAIR

In-State poultry going to exhibit must test negative for Salmonella Pullorum Typhoid (P-T), Avian Influenza, Mycoplasma Gallisepticum, and Mycoplasma Synoviae within 30 days of shipment. This rule applies to chickens, exotic fowl, and game birds; but excludes waterfowl, doves, and pigeons. **Birds under the age of 16 weeks do not need to be tested for P-T.** Exhibitors that meet one of the two options below do not need to have their birds P-T tested prior to exhibit:

- The exhibitor is a participant in the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP); or
- Within the past twelve months, the show birds were bought from:
  - NPIP participants
  - Hatcheries (must be a NPIP participant)
  - Feed stores (must be a NPIP participant)

Exhibitors that do not meet the criteria above **must** test negative for P-T within 90 days of going to exhibit. Exhibitors can meet the requirements using the options below.

1. A veterinarian, vet tech, or trained personnel can draw ½ cc of blood from each bird and send the samples to WSU Avian Health and Food Safety Laboratory in Puyallup
2. A WSDA field veterinarian can perform P-T testing at the fair.

**Keep Exotic Newcastle Disease out of Washington:** Exotic Newcastle Disease is a deadly disease caused by a virus. The extremely contagious disease affects all species of birds and is spread by contact with infected birds or materials contaminated with the virus. It does not pose a human health threat and does not affect the safety of chicken meat or eggs. Exotic Newcastle Disease has not been detected in Washington and the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) is working with the poultry and egg industries to keep it out.

### POULTRY DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES

Please also read the General Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:

- All Poultry exhibitors must state they are not in violation of WAC 16-54-1555. This rule concerns the very dangerous Newcastle Disease and the quarantine associated with it. If you need a copy of WAC 16-54-1555, please call or email us @ [agdept@fairfun.com](mailto:agdept@fairfun.com). The Central Washington State Fair reserves the right to cancel all Poultry and Pigeon Shows if circumstances warrant it.
- Feeding is provided by Central Washington State Fair.
- All birds must be in the showroom no later than 10:00 am, Wednesday, Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>, for veterinarian inspection, and remain until the close of the Fair. Birds not called for by Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 8:00 pm, will be left in coops at owner's risk.
- On entries, state plainly: sex, variety, breed, and name of exhibitor.
- Selling price must be stated on entries if sale is desired. No exhibitor will be allowed to bring birds into the showroom to be offered for sale unless entry fees have been paid thereon. No for Sale signs allowed on the cages.
- The trio shall consist of 1 male and 2 females and may be cooped together and compete only as such. Birds entered in single classes cannot compete in trios. Old and young birds must compete separately.
- The latest edition of the "American Standard of Perfection of Poultry"

will be the guide of the judges in awarding prizes on all varieties recognized therein. Varieties will be judged by comparison. Crossbred birds not accepted.

- For the purposes of this exhibition, the cock and hen shall mean birds hatched before 2020, cockerel and pullet, birds hatched in 2021. No bird under 4 months is eligible for award.
- **Special Note:** The Central Washington State Fair wishes to take every reasonable precaution to protect the health of birds on exhibit. Birds showing evidence of any condition deemed a source of contagion to other entries will be barred from entry.
- As exhibitors, please help us protect your own valuable birds as well as those of other exhibitors.
- The Fair will not be responsible for losses or accidents to specimens while in the showroom.
- All entries in the Poultry Department must be owned by the exhibitor and entered in the owner's name.
- Poultry will be on wire cage bottoms. Tar paper is available upon request. Please make notify your superintendent if you want tar paper on the bottom of your cages, so this can be prepared prior to your arrival.

You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Administrator, Joe Niemann) feels it is safe for everyone. Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.

**HERDSMANSHIP:** All exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning their cages and area every day. However, the Yakima Valley Rabbit Breeders will take care of feeding all animals over the first half of fair.
