PASSES

General Exhibits:

Exhibitors in Open/Youth Home Arts, Floriculture, Valley Produce, & 4-H General: Processing Fee of \$10.00 will be charged. One (1) pass will be assigned to each exhibitor that pays the \$10.00 fee. For the \$10.00 fee, exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish within the Modern Living Building (Foods, Threads, Crafts). Ag Building, you may enter as many as you wish in Valley Produce and Floriculture. Please see Photo and Fine Arts for their fees. No cross over between buildings. The Livestock Department is not included in this program.

Amateur - \$10.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$2.00 per each additional entry.

* Each exhibitor will receive one (1) admission pass, no matter how many entries are made in this department. (No cross entry in other departments for the \$10.00 fee.)

WOODCARVING GENERAL RULES

Please read the General Information, Rules and Regulations of the Fair.

- Only original work by the exhibitor, finished within the last two (2) years and not previously shown at the Central Washington State Fair will be eligible.
- Size of exhibit is limited to available space.
- Private business cards, notes, advertising, or any other type of commercialism on artwork will not be allowed.
- **SALES:** Those desiring to sell their work must put their price on the entry form. The Fair will charge 20% commission on all sales. The CWSF Office will mail payment for work sold, less 20% commission, after the close of the Fair. Sales will be handled by the clerk in the area. No sold items will be released until the close of the Fair.
- No Kits or Crafts - See Crafts Department.
- **You may enter either as a professional or an amateur, not both.**
Professional: Anyone who has won an award or ribbon for their work; consider their work to be above the Amateur level; is paid for their work.
Amateur: The amateur does their work for the pleasure involved and has little or no training.
- One winner per class: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
