SYSTEM OF JUDGING: American - This refers to the judging of all items in a class being judged against one another. Each class will receive one 1st place, one 2nd place and one 3rd place. Best of Show uses American judging with all 1st place in each class competing.

ENTRY FEE:

Professional - \$13.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$3.00 per each additional entry.

Amateur - \$10.00 for the first exhibit entry, \$2.00 per each additional entry. Each exhibitor will receive one (1) admission pass, no matter how many entries are made in this department. (No cross entry in other departments for the \$10.00 fee.)

Plein Air Contest: \$20 for one entry. Refer to Plein Air Contest section for additional information.

RELEASING: Tuesday, Oct. 4th, 9:00am-5:30pm. No exhibits will be mailed.

ADULT FINE ARTS GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations as stated apply to all exhibitors and entries.

- Exhibitors must be 19 years or older to be eligible to enter in the Adult Fine Arts Department.
- ALL ARTS MUST BE <u>SUITABLY FRAMED AND ADEQUATELY WIRED</u> FOR HANGING. No Exceptions. Do not tape wire to the back of artwork for hanging purposes.
- Artwork not framed, wired, without proper hardware to hand or paper alone WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!
- Fine Arts is open to everyone. Entries must be suitable for a family show.
- Amateurs must enter in amateur division, professionals in professional division.

<u>Professional:</u> Those whose work is produced for selling, are paid for their work or who advertise in any form for their services. Those who have a diploma, certificate, degree, or have three or more years of training, or teach in their media.

Amateur: Does the work for the pleasure involved; receive no money for their work; and has had little or no training.

- Only original work completed within the last two years and not previously shown at the Central Washington State Fair is eligible. Work done under instruction, copies of other's photographs or work, overpainting of photographs, a photograph finished to appear as a painting (pigment must be applied directly to canvas over artists' own drawing,) or work from Commercial Kits will not be eligible.
- Private Business Cards, notes, advertising, or any other type of commercialism on artwork will not be allowed.
- SALES: Those desiring to sell their artwork must put their price on the entry form. The Fair will charge 20% commission on all sales. The CWSF Office will mail payment for art sold less 20% commission after Fair closes. Sales will be handled by the Superintendent or clerk in the Art Department. No sold items will be released until the close of the Fair
- **CWSF Use of Art Images:** All artwork may be reproduced for marketing purposes only by the Central Washington State Fair in any publications, printed materials, social media platforms, or digital platforms without any compensation to the artist.

PLEIN AIR PAINTING CONTEST AND RULES DIVISION 202

Plein Air Painting: A painting done outside rather than in a studio. The term comes from the French en plein air, meaning 'in the open air'.

Your subject matter is entirely up to you, since you only have one (1) day to complete your painting, be selective about the size and subject matter. Plein Air painting is about what you see and not what you imagine. Consider scouting out locations in advance to decide what you're going to paint and where you would set up. This way, when you head out to paint you can spend the whole day painting and take along the best selection of colors for that particular scene. The fairgrounds hold endless possibilities for creating your work of art. There's something about seeing an artist at work that makes people extremely inquisitive so before you decide to participate, be open to the idea that our fair attendees will be visiting with you, asking questions and may even offer suggestions.

Artist must be over 19 years of age as of January of current year.

Contest open to Amateur Artists only. No professional artists.

All materials needed to complete painting are to be provided by the artist.

Items to bring and suggestions:

- Painting supplies/easel (canvas can be prepared prior).
- If hot, sunscreen and a sunhat.
- Dress in layers that you can easily take off as you get hot or put on when you get cold.
- · Fingerless gloves help keep fingers warm.
- · Stool or chair to sit on.
- Bottled water.
- · Insect repellant.
- · A Small bag for garbage.

Date of Contest: Tuesday, September 27, 2022. Artist will be allowed to paint from 11 am -7 pm. Painting to be turned into the Agriculture Building Fine Arts Display no later than 7:15 pm the day of the contest. Artwork will be displayed for the duration of the Fair.
