**SECOND HALF RELEASING:** Animals will begin leaving on October 2<sup>nd</sup> @ 6:30pm. Barns will be closed @ 6:00pm; Banner line will go up at 6:00pm. To assure guest safety no access will be allowed in the livestock area once the banner line has been installed. We are hopeful that we may clear the barn and livestock areas of fairgoers by 6:00pm, at which time exhibitors may finish hauling their tack and decorations. Please do not start dismantling any displays or decorations until 5:30pm. Once this procedure is completed, we will have a general release with an estimated release time of 6:30pm. Please keep in mind that this depends on getting the barn areas cleared of fairgoers in a timely fashion. You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Administrator, Joe Niemann) feels it is safe for everyone. Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.

## OPEN GOAT DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:

- No pre-show milk-out, over extended udders will be discriminated against.
- Two (2) animals per class except group classes. No Exceptions.
- Animals will be shown by breed - **NO male goats are allowed on the fairgrounds.**
- In all group classes, one (1) animal may be borrowed to complete a group.
- September 1<sup>st</sup> is to be used as the base date for computing ages in all classes. You may enter two (2) entries per exhibitor in each group class, providing the animals are all different.
- **All pens must be cleaned daily before the fair is open to the public (by 10:00am).**

**YOUTH GOAT DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES**

**Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:**

- Open to all youth 5-18 years old. The age you are on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the present year.
- You may enter up to age 21 with Association Membership card. Must show proof of card. Can email copy of card to [agdept@fairfun.com](mailto:agdept@fairfun.com) at time of entry.
- Youth goats are encouraged to cross enter into the Open Goat show, held concurrent.
- Animals will be shown by breed - **NO male goats are allowed on the fairgrounds.**
- You may enter only one class in Fitting and Showing.
- Please keep all grain in closed containers.
- **Exhibitors to wear white or black pants with white shirt.**
- **All pens must be cleaned daily (by 10:00am) before the fair is open to the public.**
