**LOCATION:** Barn I

**FIRST HALF:** September 23 – 25, 2022

**FIRST HALF RECEIVING:** Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 12:00pm – 7:00pm. Animal must be in place by 7:00pm for Veterinarian Inspection. Animal entry through Gate 11.

**FIRST HALF RELEASING:** Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup> – see Changeover procedure. All livestock must be out of the barns by 10:00pm. Release for long hauls (500 miles & over): See Department Superintendent for arrangements.

**CHANGEOVER:** Barns will be closed on Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00pm; Banner line will go up at 6:00pm. To assure guest safety no access will be allowed in the livestock area once the banner line has been installed. We are hopeful that we may clear the barn and livestock areas of fairgoers by 6:00pm, at which time exhibitors may finish hauling their tack and decorations. Please do not start dismantling any displays or decorations until 5:30pm. Once this procedure is completed, we will have a general release with an estimated release time of 6:30pm. Please keep in mind that this depends on getting the barn areas cleared of fairgoers in a timely fashion. You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Administrator, Joe Niemann) feels it is safe for everyone. Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.

## OPEN SHEEP DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:

- Open to all ages. Youth sheep show exhibitors may cross enter into Open Sheep Show.
- No sheep except animals entered in competition will be allowed to unload on the grounds.
- All pens must be cleaned daily before the fair is open to the public, first bedding is provided.
- All Sheep must have scrapie tags.

**The order of the show is subject to change.**

### Yearling Ewe Class Rules:

- Animals should be fitted according to breed classes.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Yearling Ewes from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

### Ewe Lamb Class Rules:

- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ewe lamb class.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed class.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ewe Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

### Ram Lamb Class Rules:

- At the judge's discretion, the top Ram Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ram lamb classes.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed classes.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

**MARKET DIVISION RULES:**

- Market lambs may cross enter into other breeding classes, Youth or Open Sheep Show.
- This is not a terminal show and there is no market sale.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the market class.
- Market lambs must be wethers or ewes. No ram lambs, short scrotum rams, or cryptorchid lambs are permitted.
- Market lambs must be slick shorn.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Market Lambs from each weight division will be brought back for the Championship Drive.
- Lambs will be weighed at the show for Class divisions.

**YOUTH SHEEP DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES**

**Please also read the General Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:**

- Open to all youth 5-18 years old.
- You may enter up to age 21 with Association Membership card. Must show proof of card. Can email copy of card to agdept@fairfun.com at time of entry.
- Youth are encouraged to also enter into the Open Sheep Show, held concurrently with the Youth Sheep Show.
- No sheep except animals entered in competition will be allowed to unload on the grounds.
- All pens must be cleaned daily before the fair is open to the public, first bedding is provided.
- All sheep must have scrapie tags.

**The order of the show is subject to change.**

**PREMIUMS:** Youth will be judged on a Danish System.

- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.
- All ages will show together in each breed class.

**Ram Lamb Class Rules:**

- At the judge's discretion, the top Ram Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ram lamb classes.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed classes.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.
