SECOND HALF: September 28 – October 2, 2022

SECOND HALF RECEIVING: Wednesday, September 29, 2022 @ 2:00am, or as soon as the barns are cleaned. Animals must be in place for Veterinarian Inspection by 10:00am. Animals arriving prior to 6:00am will be held in a holding area, unless prior arrangements with the Superintendent have been made.

SECOND HALF RELEASING: Animals will begin leaving on October 2nd @ 6:30pm. Barns will be closed @ 6:00pm; Banner line will go up at 6:00pm. To assure guest safety no access will be allowed in the livestock area once the banner line has been installed. We are hopeful that we may clear the barn and livestock areas of fairgoers by 6:00pm, at which time exhibitors may finish hauling their tack and decorations. Please do not start dismantling any displays or decorations until 5:30pm. Once this procedure is completed, we will have a general release with an estimated release time of 6:30pm. Please keep in mind that this depends on getting the barn areas cleared of fairgoers in a timely fashion. You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Administrator, Joe Niemann) feels it is safe for everyone. Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.

OPEN SHEEP DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements:

- Open to all ages. Youth sheep show exhibitors may cross enter into Open Sheep Show.
- No sheep except animals entered in competition will be allowed to unload on the grounds.
- All pens must be cleaned daily before the fair is open to the public, first bedding is provided.
- All Sheep must have scrapie tags.

The order of the show is subject to change.

Yearling Ewe Class Rules:

- Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 yearling ewes.
- Animals should be fitted according to breed classes.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Yearling Ewes from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

Ewe Lamb Class Rules:

- Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 ewe lambs.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ewe lamb class.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed class.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ewe Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

Ram Lamb Class Rules:

- Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 ram lambs.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ram Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ram lamb classes.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed classes.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

ADULT MARKET SHEEP**

MARKET DIVISION RULES:

- Market lambs may cross enter into other breeding classes, Youth or Open Sheep Show.
- Exhibitor may enter up to 2 market lambs. This is not a terminal show and there is no market sale.
- All breeds will be shown together in the market classes
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth and born after January 1, 2021 will be eligible to show in the market class.
- Market lambs must be wethers or ewes. No ram lambs, short scrotum rams, or cryptorchid lambs are permitted.
- Market lambs must be slick shorn.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Market Lambs will be brought back for the Championship Drive.

- You may enter up to age 21 with Association Membership card. Must show proof of card. Can email copy of card to agdept@fairfun.com at time of entry.
- Youth are encouraged to also enter into the Open Sheep Show, held concurrently with the Youth Sheep Show.
- No sheep except animals entered in competition will be allowed to unload on the grounds.
- All pens must be cleaned daily before the fair is open to the public, first bedding is provided.
- All sheep must have scrapie tags.

The order of the show is subject to change.

- Each exhibitor may enter up the 5 ewe lambs.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ewe lamb class.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed class.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ewe Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship drive.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.
- All ages will show together in each breed class.

Ram Lamb Class Rules:

- Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 ram lambs.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ram Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ram lamb classes.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed classes.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

- Exhibitor may enter up to 2 market lambs. This is not a terminal show and there is no market sale.
- All breeds will be shown together in the market classes.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth and born after January 1, 2021 will be eligible to show in the market class.
- Market lambs must be wethers or ewes. No ram lambs, short scrotum rams, or cryptorchid lambs are permitted.
- Market lambs must be slick shorn.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Market Lambs will be brought back for the Championship Drive.
