WOODCARVING GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations as stated apply to all exhibitors and entries

- Only original work by the exhibitor, finished within the last two (2) years and not previously shown at the Central Washington State Fair will be eligible.
- Size of exhibit is limited to available space.
- Private business cards, notes, advertising, or any other type of commercialism on artwork will not be allowed.
- **SALES:** Those desiring to sell their work must put their price on the entry form. The Fair will charge 20% commission on all sales. The CWSF Office will mail payment for work sold, less 20% commission, after the close of the Fair. Sales will be handled by the clerk in the area. No sold items will be released until the close of the Fair.
- No Kits or Crafts See Crafts Department.
- You may enter either as a professional or an amateur, not both.

Professional: Anyone who has won an award or ribbon for their work; consider their work to be above the Amateur level; is paid for their work.

Amateur: The amateur does their work for the pleasure involved and has little or no training.

One winner per class: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
