Open to all youth up to 18 years of age who own their own poultry. 19 if birthday is after January 1<sup>st</sup> of present year, or 20-21 with a current FFA or Association membership card. Must show proof of card.

### Class

1. Youth Poultry Mini Poster - Create an 8 ½ inch x 11 inch 'poster' that will be displayed in a cage. Information to include photo of youth with bird, name of bird, breed and why exhibitor chose that breed. Fair staff will then get 'poster' mounted and displayed in the cage. Judging will be based on information provided as well as creativity of mini poster.

Poultry Presentation – Create a presentation on any poultry related topic. Presentations will be done Friday, Saturday and Sunday (September 23-25) at 1 pm, 3 pm or 5 pm. Presentations to last at least 10-15 minutes. Topic ideas: poultry nutrition, breed selection, egg production, etc. Judging will be based on Exhibitors Appearance, Poise and Posture, Voice Quality, Presentation Content, Expression (Eye Contact, Body Language), and Response to Questions.

**Youth Poultry Herdsmanship Award  
NEW FOR 2022**

**Exhibitors will be evaluated based on the following criteria: 20 Points for submitting a Mini Poster, 30 Points for doing a Poultry Presentation, 30 Points for Fitting and Showing Participation, 10 Points for Attendance each day, 10 Points for helpfulness.**

Exhibitors will be judged throughout 5 days on their Herdsmanship in the poultry barn.
