ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 will be charged. One (1) fair admission ticket will be given to each exhibitor who pays the \$10.00 fee and brings their item(s) for receiving and judging. You will manually need to select Crafts, Foods, Threads Department fee to pay for entry fee.

ENTRY LIMIT: Exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish within the Foods, Threads and Crafts Departments that are on display in the Modern Living Building unless otherwise noted.

PREMIUMS: Blue - \$4.00 Red - \$2.00 White – Ribbon Only

Best of Class Award may be awarded if judge deems worthy, & only if enough entries qualify in a class.

ADULT AND YOUTH CRAFTS DEPARTMENT RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations as stated apply to all exhibitors and entries.

- Youth Ages: 5-18 years as of January 1 of the current year.
- Adult Ages: over 18 years as of January 1 of the current year.
- Items that are duplicated or alike will not be acceptable. If they are considered a "set", they will be put on one (1) entry tag and judged as one (1) item.
- No group entries will be received in Crafts.
- The Judges reserve the right to give or withhold awards according to the judges' decision, except when subsequent to the judging, an entry is discovered not to comply with the rules.
- You may enter up to <u>4 different items</u> in each class, unless specified differently under the Craft Division. You must specify items and describe fully on the Entry Form. Items with a different pattern will be accepted; those with the same pattern, but a different color will not be accepted.
- All framed entries must be ready to hang.
- An exhibitor in Crafts is not eligible to enter a duplicate or like item in other areas of the Fair.
- No dioramas any exhibit that contains small pieces that may come apart.
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor. Items must be finished: new, clean, and made within the last two years.
- Items may not have been entered into a previous Central Washington State Fair.
- Articles stained, soiled, or showing wear will not be judged.
- In the event an entry is disqualified, exhibitor will not be refunded entry fee(s).
- Exhibitors entering more than 20 items must check in on receiving day no later than 2 hour before receiving ends
- The Danish System of Judging will apply to all Craft, Foods and Threads Department areas EXCEPT Special Contests and Awards or otherwise indicated. Each entry is judged individually according to a standard. A Blue Ribbon means 1st Place, a Red Ribbon means 2nd Place, a White Ribbon means 3rd Place. There can be more than one placing in each of these categories, if they meet the required standard. If an entry does not meet the required standard, then no ribbon is given. Prizes and Prize Money (Premiums) are paid from the records of the judges' sheets. Ribbons, tags, etc. have no value.

ADULT BASKETRY

Professional level is defined as someone with more than 10 years' experience in making baskets, won more than five (5) 1st Place ribbons, and sells baskets.
