New Swine Identification Requirements

The Washington State Department of Agriculture is now requiring that all exhibition swine that leave the farm of origin **MUST** have official USDA-approved identification.

SWINE DEPARTMENT GENERAL RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations of the Fair & Livestock Entry Requirements, with the following requirements. The Swine Health Record form must be filled out and turned in to your Superintendent or the entry office prior to arriving or upon arrival at the fairgrounds. This form is for both Washington State and Out-of-State animals.

- All swine entering Washington State must be accompanied by an entry permit, a certificate of veterinary inspection, and official USDA approved identification. The certificate of veterinary inspection must contain the following certification: "To the best of my knowledge, swine represented on this certificate have not originated from premises known to be affected by Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus (PEDv), and have not been exposed to PEDv within the last 30 days." The certification must be signed by both the owner of the swine and the certifying veterinarian.
- Entries: The show shall be open to all exhibitors. Each exhibitor may show no more than 2 animals in each class.
- Disqualifications:
 - a. Any swine showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from showing in any breeding class.
 - b. Any gilt over 14 months that has not farrowed and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
- Please use separate entry form for "Open" and "Youth" entries.
- **BEDDING REQUIREMENTS:** All swine pens must be completely **CLEANED OUT** and **RE-BEDDED** by 10:00AM **DAILY** or premiums will not be paid. **Shavings only to be used in the swine stalls – no straw.**
- Breeds: All breeds will be shown together unless six (6) animals are entered per breed in the breeding classes.
- Junior & Senior Classes will compete by breed for ribbons prior to selection of Grand Champions

WATERING METHODS

For sanitation reasons and to keep the swine exhibit area cleaner for the animals and the public, starting in 2024, all swine exhibitors are to provide water to their swine using a nipple water device. One nipple watering device per pen. No open watering will be allowed.

FIRST HALF: September 20 – 24, 2024

FIRST HALF RECEIVING: Thursday, September 19, 2024, 12:00pm – 7:00pm. Animals must be in place for Veterinarian Inspection by 7:00pm. Animals arriving prior to 6:00am will be held in a holding area, unless prior arrangements with the Superintendent have been made.

CHANGEOVER: Animals will begin leaving on September 24th @ 6:30pm. Barns will be closed @ 6:00pm; Banner line will go up at 6:00pm. To assure guest safety no access will be allowed in the livestock area once the banner line has been

installed. We are hopeful that we may clear the barn and livestock areas of fairgoers by 6:00pm, at which time exhibitors may finish hauling their tack and decorations. Please do not start dismantling any displays or decorations until 5:30pm. Once this procedure is completed, we will have a general release with an estimated release time of 6:30pm. Please keep in mind that this depends on getting the barn areas cleared of fairgoers in a timely fashion. You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Show Supervisor) feels it is safe for everyone. Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.
