Kathy Kramer, President and CEO of the Central Washington Fair Association said, "It's unfortunate we have to cancel this year's 4th of July Celebration; however, our priority is the health and safety of our guests, staff, and vendors. Although we will not be able to gather at State Fair Park with friends and family to celebrate this 4th of July, mark your calendar for next year's celebration which will be even bigger and better."

Plans are already underway for the 2021 4th of July Celebration. "We are excited to announce Yakima Federal Savings and Loan as an event sponsor. We can also confirm the annual Yakima APPLE JAM, featuring live, local bands and vendors will be back in 2021" said Kramer. More food vendors and family-friendly activities are being planned, as well as a crowd favorite - carnival rides.

State Fair Park, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, produces this community give-back event to preserve a beloved 4th of July tradition for Valley residents.
