MUST PRE-REGISTER BY SEPTEMBER 14, 2021

SUBJECT: FFA Judging Contest; FFA Horticulture Exhibits; FFA Ag Mechanics

If your school has entered the Horticulture or Ag Mechanics competitions, the students involved with those projects will be allowed to come on **Tuesday, September 28, 2021** with the Judging Contest Students. All students must be pre-registered with our office. Please see form enclosed.

ADMISSION: Judging Team Members, FFA exhibitors, and Instructors will be admitted to the Fairgrounds between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM through the Red Gate VIA GATE 11. FFA Instructors must send or email a list (see the form attached) of students, instructors, bus drivers to us by **Tuesday, September 14th**. We will not be issuing tickets. You will need to request parking credentials however, see form attached.

Access to the exhibit buildings, rides, and commercial displays will not be allowed prior to the 12:00 PM opening of the Fair except for the Agriculture Building. You must stay in the FFA judging areas or the Agriculture Building until the 12:00 PM opening.

Parking Credentials must be on all vehicles. Please note on the registration form how many parking credentials you will need. Vehicles will not be allowed to park without a Parking Credential.

REMINDER: Each school will be allowed two (2) official teams of five (5) members each plus two (2) alternates for each judging contest (Dairy, Livestock, Horse). Team member must meet requirements as stipulated in the FFA Awards and Judging Contest Handbook. You will score your own alternates scores. Tractor Driving allows two (2) students per school. You are welcome to bring as many students to FFA Day as you wish, but only the allotted number of students will be allowed to participate in contests.
