CHANGEOVER

Barns will be closed on Sunday, October 4th at 6:00pm; Banner line will go up at 6:00pm.

To assure guest safety no access will be allowed in the livestock area once the banner line has been installed. We are hopeful that we may clear the barn and livestock areas of fairgoers by 6:30pm, at which time exhibitors may finish hauling their tack and decorations.

Please do not start dismantling any displays or decorations until 5:30pm. Once this procedure is completed, we will have a general release with an estimated release time of 6:30pm. Please keep in mind that this depends on getting the barn areas cleared of fairgoers in a timely fashion.

You will be informed by your Superintendent of a definite release time once management (Livestock Show Supervisor) feels it is safe for everyone.

Long hauls will be given consideration for an earlier release if it is safe to do so. Gators and drivers will be available to assist you in hauling your tack and/or display items.

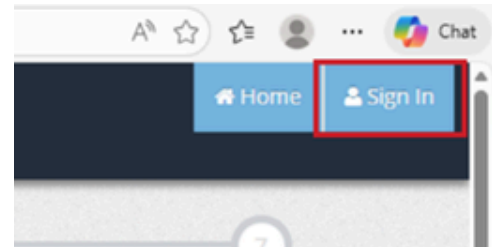

OPEN SHEEP BREEDS DEPARTMENT RULES

Please also read the CWSF Rules and Regulations. All rules and regulations as stated apply to all exhibitors and entries.

- Open to all ages. Youth sheep show exhibitors may cross enter into Open Sheep Show.
- No sheep except animals entered in competition will be allowed to unload on the grounds.
- All pens must be cleaned daily by 10am, bedding is provided.
- All Sheep must have scrapie tags.
- Lambs should be fitted according to breed class.
- Lamb breed classes may be split by birthdate.

Yearling Ewe Class Rules:

- At the judge's discretion, the top Yearling Ewes from each class will be brought back for the championship class.

Ewe Lamb Class Rules:

- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ewe lamb class.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Ewe Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class

Ram Lamb Class Rules:

- At the judge's discretion, the top Ram Lambs from each class will be brought back for the championship class.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the ram lamb classes.

OPEN MARKET SHEEP DIVISION 2013

Division Rules

- Market lambs may cross enter into other breeding classes, Youth or Open Sheep Show.
- This is not a terminal show and there is no market sale.
- Only those lambs having lamb teeth will be eligible to show in the market class.
- Market lambs must be wethers or ewes. No ram lambs, short scrotum rams, or cryptorchid lambs are permitted.
- Market lambs must be slick shorn.
- At the judge's discretion, the top Market Lambs from each weight division will be brought back for the Championship Drive.
- Lambs will be weighed at the show for Class divisions. Lambs will be divided into Prospect or Market class at weigh in.

- Fitting and Showing is not mandatory.
- Enter age you were on January 1 of 2026.

3. Intermediate: ages 12-14
4. Senior: ages 15-18*
