

Middle School Og Exploration Event State Fair of Virginia

Contest Rules:

- 1. Each FFA Chapter is invited to enter up to 2 teams of 3 or 4 individuals. Team ranking is determined by combining the scores of the top three students from each team. All four members are eligible for awards.
- 2. Contestants must be an active FFA member who is enrolled in an agricultural education course during the school term preceding entry in the contest.
- 3. Pre-registration is required by September 15th.
- 4. The purpose of this contest is to demonstrate knowledge of agriculture concepts related to:

(Every Year) FFA Knowledge: 25 Question Quiz (2 points each, 50 points total)

(Even Years) Ag Technology and Mechanics: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points total)

(Odd Years) Food and Fiber: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points total)

(Even Years) Plant Science: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points total)

(Odd Years) Small Animal: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points total)

- 5. This contest will utilize 6, 12-minute rotations and will be adjusted as needed.
- 6. Maximum score is 150 points. The tiebreaker will be the guiz score.
