- Originality:** All work submitted must be the original work of the student. If a work is found to be plagiarized, copied in its entirety or in intent, it will be disqualified. Computer generated art and photography will not be accepted at this time.
- Submission:** One artwork per student only. Entries are only eligible for scholarship competition once. New artwork must be submitted each year.
- Artist Statement:** Along with original piece, student must also submit a typed, one-page (500 words or less) artist statement. Pieces will not be accepted without artist statement.

- Medium:** Original, three-dimensional art no larger than 2' x 2' x 2', weighing less than 20 lbs. Entry must have been completed within the last year.
- Originality:** All work submitted must be the original work of the student. If a work is found to be plagiarized, copied in its entirety or in intent, it will be disqualified. Submission: One three-dimensional artwork submission per student.
- Submission:** One entry per student only. Entries are only eligible for scholarship competition once. New artwork must be submitted each year.
- Artist Statement:** Along with original piece, student must also submit a typed, one-page (500 words or less) artist statement. Pieces will not be accepted without artist statement.
- Identification:** Completed student information form must be mailed or delivered with submission of artwork.

**Originality:** All work submitted must be the original work of the student. If a work is found to be plagiarized, copied in its entirety or in intent, it will be disqualified. Computer generated art and photography will not be accepted at this time.

**Submission:** One artwork per student only. Entries are only eligible for scholarship competition once. New artwork must be submitted each year.

**Submission:** One submission entry per student only.

**Presentation:** Submission should be educational, promoting Virginia Natural Resources including but not limited to: State Parks, outdoor recreation (DCR), Virginia wildlife (DWR), Virginia's historic landsites (DHR), Virginia's marine life, habitats and resources (VMRC), and/or Virginia's environmental quality (DEQ).

Student's name, home address, county, home phone number and school name. Identification will be removed for the actual judging process.

**Delivery:** **Infographics/flyers/posters should be delivered during normal Creative Arts Competition Delivery prior to the State Fair for judging.**

**Open to:** Students in **Students in high school or age 18 or under as of Sept. 1 across**

**Format:** **Virginia** across Virginia Recipe must be a dish from another country.

**Originality:** All work submitted must be made by the student. If entry is found to be made by someone other than the student, it will be disqualified.

**Submission:** One entry per student only. Entries are only eligible for scholarship competition. Delivered September 25, 2024 from 7:30 am to 10:30 am with all other culinary competitions (excluding peanuts).

**Educational Piece:** Along with international culinary favorite **and recipe**, student must also submit an educational brochure, flyer, poster, handout, display etc. on the food's country of origin. Educational piece should also include a brief background or impact of agriculture on food in the country (top commodities, seasonal and cultural foods, imports/exports, etc.). Educational pieces may be shared, replicated, and reused by and with the SFVA and any scholarship competition sponsors. Pieces will not be accepted without educational ag component and typed recipe.
