

A Step into Nature: Natural Resources Beautification

Natural Resources partners moved from their former Dominion Classroom location into the interior of the Farm Bureau Center for the 2021 fair, significantly increasing their foot traffic!

Our next opportunity is to transform the open, concrete, metal space into a space where youth get excited about Virginia's outdoors. We are working with external design partners to create a transformative and imaginative experience among our educational partners and their exhibits similar

to what one may find in a children's museum.



Dairy Days and The Milk Mustache Challenge

The 2023 State Fair of Virginia will be hosting our second annual Milk Mustache Contest as part of our 'dairy day/weekend' partnership with the Federation of Virginia Food Banks, Virginia State Dairymen's Association, and the Virginia Tech Dairy Science Club to highlight the Federation's "Milk for Good" campaign in coordination with the dairy shows happening during the opening weekend of the fair.

Milk is one of the most requested, yet least received items at the food bank. Established in 2019, Milk for Good has supported the distribution of over 200,000 half gallons of fresh, locally processed milk to Virginia families. During the 2022 SFVA Inaugural Dairy Days, over \$7,000 was raised for the program, providing over 3,000 half gallons of milk for families in need.

We are seeking sponsors to help make this event successful by introducing fun, interactive dairy programming to highlight all the good that Milk for Good does in Virginia, both in supporting farmers and families in need.







Giant Pumpkin Weigh-Off

Every year, our Giant Pumpkin and Veggie weigh-off and exhibit is a popular attraction for fairgoers, always captivating the crowd throughout the 10 days. However, during the actual weigh-off on the first Saturday, the interest wanes and the crowds disperse due to the time involved in moving the giants on and off the scale.

In 2022, we capitalized on the crowd by engaging the general public with Ag Trivia during the weighoff as giant admirers had a chance to win fair tickets and goodies by showing off their ag knowledge. In 2023, we are asking the ag community to help sponsor this adored exhibit so we can incentivize our growers with more competitive premiums and grow our programming.


