MATH and SOCIAL SCIENCE LESSONS:

WHERE DOES YOUR VIRGINIA AG HERO LIVE?

<u>SOLS</u>: History and Social Studies - Skills - all grade levels, 1.6, 2.11, 2.13; VS.1 VS.13; Math 2.6, 3.3, 4.4(b), 5.4

<u>Objective</u>: The student will apply history and social science skills to the content by developing questions, demonstrating curiosity, and engaging in critical thinking and analysis, comparing and contrasting people, places, and events; identifying cause-and-effect relationships to clarify and explain content; using economic decision-making models to make informed economic decisions. The student will apply history and social science skills to develop geographic skills. The student will apply history and social science skills to explain Virginia's role in the global economy in the 21st Century. The student will estimate and determine the sum or difference of two whole numbers. The student will create and solve single-step and multi-step practical problems involving addition and subtraction.

Materials: Map of Virginia worksheet/student

<u>Procedure:</u> The student will mark the home area for 5 AG Heroes representing at least three different regions on the Virginia map. The student will select one AG Hero and identify at least 3 unique features of that location that help and/or impact the life or career of that AG Hero.

The student will estimate and determine the distance between the home towns of the 5 AG Heroes they plotted on their map.
