The vision for the Virginia Farm Festival grew out of a desire to expand the educational components of the State Fair of Virginia into a new spring event in order to tell the story of spring planting and all the work that takes place before growth and harvest.

Our goal for this "sister" event is to grow it and maintain a solid focus on agriculture & outdoor education as we work to grow our yearlong commitment to serving Virginia's youth, families, and agricultural communities as Virginia's Largest Outdoor Classroom.

This event successfully launched in May of 2021 as one of the region's first live events to take place! **Over 6,000 attendees** enjoyed being outdoors and learning more about agriculture.

The Farm Festival is our opportunity to:

- Highlight the interconnectedness of agriculture and health in our lives
- Bring awareness to challenges in our food system from food access to nutrition
- Further serve underserved communities through our programming
