The Eastern States Exposition Museum represents a culmination of the unique of the organization. From its origins in 1916 to latest and greatest entertainment at the Big E, the Museum covers a wide range of topics.

Storrowton Village Museum is a collection of 18th and 19th century buildings from Massachusetts and New Hampshire, with various programs throughout the year.



Accessibility:

The ESE Museum is wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair accessible restrooms are available at this location.

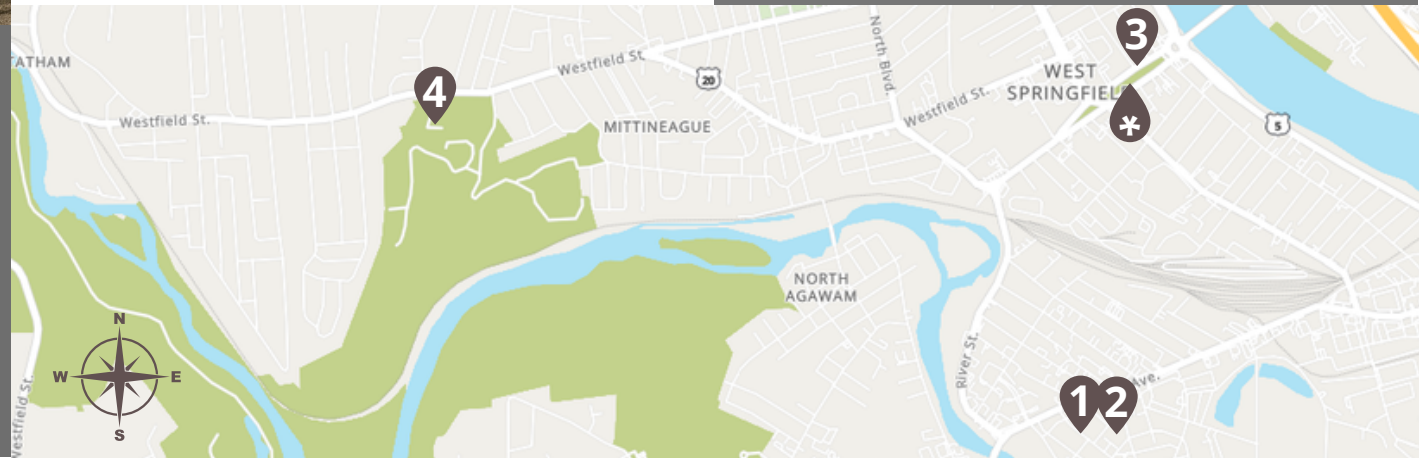


Josiah Day House

The Josiah Day House is a brick saltbox house built in 1754, sitting on its original plot of land. The Josiah Day House is full of 18th century history and covers the story of the prominent Day Family.

Accessibility:

The Josiah Day House is not wheelchair accessible, but does feature an audio tour at the exterior of the house that can be accessed by scanning a QR Code.



Altamont Museum

The Altamont Museum is West Springfield's Town Museum, covering West Springfield history throughout the ages. Discover interesting exhibits that cover the, perhaps, mostly unknown bits of local history.



Accessibility:
