The purpose of this competition is to allow Twin Falls County FFA members an opportunity to showcase their skills, talent, and hard work to the public.

- To be eligible to participate youth must be official FFA members in good standing. **Members are eligible up to the Summer immediately after graduation.**
- **Member may submit only one entry per class.**
- There will be an overall winning chapter, this will be awarded based on total points from each category.
- **Interview participants will not receive an interview score if not in Official FFA uniform per dress code.**
- There will be a public vote to select a **“People’s Choice Award”** for best overall project.

Competition components:

- Project – Projects may be completed using any tools/machines available, including plasma CNC table, CNC mill machines etc.
- Plans – Participants are required to submit plans with their entries including bill of materials. Plans may be hand drawn or digitally made.
- Project card – To be displayed with project – must include participant name, FFA Chapter, FFA advisor, hours to construct, and total cost. Participants may also include information relating to selling the project if they wish.

Class distinctions – all size classes will be based on footprint size of the project. Each project may only be entered in one class.
