Deadline for entries is Friday, October 7, 2022.

Move in Date: Thursday, October 13, 2022 12:00 pm – 10:00 pm

Friday, October 14, 2022 8:00 am - 5:00 pm

Driving in the grounds outside of move in times (GUEST INCLUDED) or open gate times (TBD) will get you an immediate disqualification.

Tear down: Sunday, October 16, 2022 by 10 a.m.

Space size: 40 x 40

Additional 40 x 40 spaces available.

Port-O-Can: \$75 each

Ice: Cash only

Rules and Regulations:

1. Cook-off dates are October 14 and 15, 2022.
2. Deadline for entries is Friday, October 7, 2022.
3. Move in: Move in date is Thursday, October 13 after 12:00 pm. No one may move in after 10:00 pm on Thursday. Move in **MUST** be complete on Friday, October 14th by 5:00 pm. **DRIVING IN COOKOFF AREA OUTSIDE OF MOVE IN OR OPEN GATE TIMES WILL MEAN AN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION, YOUR GUEST INCLUDED. COOK TEAMS RESPONSIBILITIES ARE TO INFORM EVERYONE IN THEIR AREA.**
4. Trash: Each cooking team will be responsible for keeping their area clean. There will be trash receptacles placed throughout the team area for your use. It will be each team's responsibility to empty the trash receptacles when the garbage vehicle comes around to your area.
5. Tear down: Tear down is on Sunday, October 16th. No team will be allowed move out until Sunday morning, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. All teams **MUST** be completely moved out on Sunday, October 16th by 10:00 am. Each team is responsible for making sure your area is clean upon leaving the cook-off. A clean up fee may be charged if area is not left clean. You will also need to sign off on your area when you move out.
6. Location: TVE Fair Grounds, 321 FM 563 (Wallisville Rd), Liberty, Texas 77575
7. Entry fee is \$120 per team. This includes the following categories: Chicken, Brisket, Ribs, Fajitas, Chef's Entree, Beans, Margaritas, and Chef's Dessert. After the deadline the entry fee will increase to \$170. There is a limit of 100 teams for this event and is on a FCFS basis.
8. Brisket Buy In: Additional brisket buy in is \$40 per entry, with a limit of 1 per team.
9. Optional Jackpot includes: 1" Ribeye - \$20, Bloody Mary - \$20. Optional Jackpot does not count for overall points. Each team may enter one or both with as many entries bought in as you see fit. Jackpots will be determined on amount of entries and split 50/50 between the house and the 1st place winner of each category.
10. Best Overall: Best Overall will be based strictly on points. The team with the highest points will win all prizes related to the Best Overall.
11. Showmanship Award: There is no additional cost for the Showmanship Award. The judging will begin Friday night and end Saturday at 5 pm. Theme is at the discretion of the team. Showmanship will be judged on cleanliness, appearance, and friendliness. There will be trophies awarded for first, second, and third places. Please notify the BBQ committee if you wish to participate in the showmanship judging.
12. Chief Cook's Meeting: There will be a chief cook's meeting on Friday, October 14th at 5:00 pm in the Hospitality Tent. We will discuss all the turn in times for Friday and Saturday and what times we will be coming around to tag your meat.
13. Prizes and Money: Prizes and money will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places in each category. This is based on full participation of 100 teams.
14. Space size: One 40 x 40 space is included per entry. Additional 40 x 40 spaces are available for \$120 per space, and must be paid at time of entry. All props (store fronts), tents, coverings, and equipment must be confined to the assigned areas. Teams should bring with them such suitable shelters as weather may require.
15. Travel Trailer/RV: Each team is restricted to one travel trailer or recreational vehicle in their cooking area, no modular trailers will be allowed. There are **NO RV HOOKUPS** outside of the BBQ spots. RV's must be in a 40x40 spot purchased along with your BBQ spot.
16. Port-O-Can: Port-O-Cans are available for your space at the cost of \$75 each. Port-O-Cans must be paid at the time of entry.
17. Vehicles: There will be **NO VEHICLES (including motorcycles)** allowed to stay in the 40X40 cook space during the cook off. Vehicles will be allowed back in at the end of the cook off. No vehicles will be allowed in or behind cooking areas between the bathrooms and the livestock barn. It is your responsibility to inform your guest of these rules.

18. Golf Car/ATV/Motorcycle: There will be **NO GOLF CART OR ATV's** allowed at the cook off, except those used by the BBQ committee members for committee business. It is your responsibility to inform your guest of these rules.

****Your cooperation in these traffic specifications will make a safer area for your team members and guests****

19. All music and PA systems are required to be off during the following times:
Friday, October 14, 12am-7am, Saturday, October 15, 2021 1:00 am - 7:00 am, Sunday, 2 am – 7 am. **All gates on the grounds will be locked during these times. Any vehicles parked once the gates are locked will stay until the gates are reopened by committee staff at designated times.**
20. There will be no bands, DJ's, or karaoke allowed on Saturday Night, October 15th from 7 pm to 11:59 pm because TVE will be hosting a concert and dance in the area. All music and PA systems must shut down at 2 am.
21. Teams will supply all equipment and supplies. This includes but is not limited to cookers, generators, power plants, water, and buckets to catch all pit run-off, and trash cans inside their space. There is not electricity or water in the BBQ spots, you must be self-contained.
22. The chief cook will be responsible for all of his or her team members and guests to make sure they conduct themselves in an orderly manner and adhere to the rules.
23. All members of the cooking team or guests will wear proper clothing at all times. Public nudity and lewdness are against the law in the City of Liberty and tickets or arrest will be made by law enforcement officers.
24. This is a free event; teams may **NOT** charge the public to enter their space. You may have sponsors for your team, but you can't charge admission to your space.
25. **NO GLASS BOTTLES ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.** The excessive use of alcoholic beverages and underage drinking will be grounds for disqualification and removal.
26. All cooking teams and their associates agree to greet and provide professional services to all guest. They also agree to work with the BBQ Committee, TVE volunteers, and staff in a positive manner.
27. Cooking: Must use wood or wood substance only; no electric, pellet cookers, or propane allowed. With the exception of Chef's Entrée, Chef's Dessert, and Youth Chef's Choice. All fires must be in containers and not on the ground. Hot coals or ashes should not be disposed of in the trash containers or on the grounds.
28. All meats and perishables must be on ice or cold storage upon arrival and remain on ice or in cold storage until used. All meats will be inspected on Friday night by a BBQ Committee representative.
29. Holes or dug pits are not allowed.
30. Ice: Ice will be available through the BBQ Committee for an amount TBD and must be paid in cash.
31. Teams exhibit at their own risk. The TVE, BBQ Committee members, its members or agents, assume no liability and will not be held responsible for injury, theft, damage of any kind.
32. No concealed weapons allowed on the premises.
33. **No pets allowed on the premises.**
34. Once a team is accepted, they are committed to show.
35. There are no rain dates or refunds. (This includes acts of God i.e. hurricanes).
36. TVE and the BBQ Committee reserves the right to reject any entry or to remove any contestant or team found to be breaking the rules/regulations or whose conduct is found to be unfavorable to the event or its guests. Removal from the grounds/misconduct of regulations could warrant a disqualification of all awards/prizes won. It is the Chief cook's responsibility to inform all guest in or leaving of the rules and to insure they are being followed or immediate disqualification.
37. The Committee Chairman reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant.
38. Decisions of the Committee Chairman and Judges are final.

Barbecue Cook-off Category Regulations

Entry Rules:

****These rules apply to each division, unless otherwise specifically noted****

1. The chief cook may be asked to sample his or her entry.
2. Each team will be responsible for delivering their entry on time **in the container provided by the BBQ Committee** to the judging area. Committee chairman only can excuse a late turn in.
3. Winners will be announced TBA on Saturday, October 15th. Time will be announced at the chief cook's meeting.
4. Only Chef's Entrée, Chef's Dessert, Margarita, and Bloody Mary may contain garnish. Other than these entries all others will be disqualified. Cooked on sauce or natural gravy from the meat is acceptable.

Fajitas:

1. Fajita will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. Fajitas will be chicken, beef, or chicken/beef combination only, no seafood.
3. No sauces or garnishes after fajitas have been placed in the judging container.
4. Team members can begin turning in fajita entry at 7:45 pm, Friday.
NO FAJITA ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8:00 PM, judging begins at 8 pm.

Margaritas:

1. Margaritas will be judged on visual appearance and taste.
2. Margaritas can be frozen or on the rocks.
3. Margaritas may include anything that will fit in the cup provided by the committee.
4. Team members can begin turning in margarita entry at 8:45 pm, Friday.
NO MARGARITA ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 9:00 PM, judging begins at 9 pm.

Beans:

1. Only dry beans will be accepted.
2. Beans will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
3. A BBQ committee member will view the uncooked beans prior to cooking.
4. No meat or rice turned in with beans.
5. Must be enough for 9 judges.
6. Team members can begin turning in bean entry at 11:45 am, Saturday.
NO BEAN ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12:00 PM, judging begins at 12 pm.

Chicken:

1. Chicken will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. No sauces or garnish after chicken has been placed in the judging container.
3. There must be a whole ½, fully jointed chicken, including breast, thigh, and drumstick for presentation along with nine (9) bite size pieces for judging.
4. Team members can begin turning in chicken entry at 12:45 pm, Saturday.
NO CHICKEN ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 1:00 pm, judging begins at 1 pm.

Chef's Entree:

1. Chef's Entree will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. Chef's Entree will be whatever entrée the cooking team wants to prepare. No desserts.
3. Judges will cut as they taste. Be prepared for 10 judges.
4. Entry MUST BE prepared at cook-off in your 40 X 40 area.
5. All items must be edible. No non-food garnishes.
6. Team members can begin turning in their entry at 1:45 pm, Saturday.
NO CHEF'S ENTRÉE ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 2:00 pm, judging begins at 2 pm.

Chef's Dessert:

1. Chef's Dessert will be judged on appearance, taste, and tenderness.
2. Chef's Dessert will be whatever dessert the cooking team wants to prepare. No meats.
3. Desserts cannot be store bought and cannot require refrigeration.
4. Prepare for 10 judges.
5. All items must be edible. No non-food garnishes.
6. Entry MUST BE prepared at cook-off in your 40 X 40 area.
7. Team members can begin turning in their entry at 3:45 pm, Saturday.
NO CHEF'S DESSERT ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 4:00 pm, judging begins at 4 pm.

Ribs:

1. Ribs will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. Three (3) racks of ribs will be inspected per entry. Must be raw and dry when inspected.
3. Ribs must be inspected between 1:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Friday, October 14th.
4. Ribs must be turned in cut up individually (bone in) and placed in the tray, top up, lying parallel to the hinge, St. Louis cut acceptable.
5. No sauces or garnishes after ribs have been placed in the judging container.
6. Team members can begin turning in Rib entry at 2:45 pm, Saturday.
NO RIB ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 3:00 pm, judging begins at 3 pm.

Brisket:

1. Brisket will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. Two (2) briskets will be inspected per entry.
3. Briskets must be raw and dry when inspected.
4. Briskets will be inspected between the hours of 1:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Friday October 14th.
5. Brisket is to be placed in tray parallel to hinge and cut less than ½ inch thick.
6. No sauces or garnish after brisket has been placed in the judging container.
7. Team members can begin turning in brisket entry at 4:45 pm, Saturday.
NO BRISKET ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 5:00 pm, judging begins at 5 pm.

Optional Jackpot – Ribeye:

TVE is a non-profit organization and this event is tax deductible.

For October 14 – 15, 2022 Cook-Off

1. Ribeye will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, and tenderness.
2. Ribeye must be 1 inch thick and cooked to medium.
3. Ribeye must be raw and dry when inspected.
4. Ribeye will be inspected directly after chief cook's meeting.
5. No sauces or garnish after ribeye has been placed in the judging container.
6. Team members can begin turning in ribeye entry at 6:30 pm, Friday.
NO RIBEYE ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 6:45 pm, judging will begin at 6:45 pm.

Optional Jackpot – Bloody Mary:

1. Bloody Mary will be judged on visual appearance and taste.
2. Bloody Mary may include anything that will fit in the cup provided, without additional support for the cup to remain upright.
3. Team members can begin turning in bloody mary entry at 9:45 am, Saturday.
NO BLOODY MARY ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 10:00 AM, judging will begin at 10 am.

***Chief cooks will have 1 hour after the chief cook meeting to acknowledge any error in boxes received for the cook off entries. Chairman must be consulted after this time.

***2 warnings will be given for any breaking of any rule. Upon the 3rd instance immediate disqualification and forfeiture of prizes will incur. CHAIRMAN HAS THE FINAL SAY.

A Calcutta will be done after judging has concluded on Friday night.
