

# TVE Youth Rodeo

## General Rules

### Dress Code

- Western Attire is required when competing
- Long Sleeved shirt tucked in, rolled down and buttoned with the exception of rough stock on riding arm during event
- Cowboy hats are optional, NO ball caps
- Boots (peanuts optional)

### Disqualifications (Parents & Contestants)

- Name will be called 3 times only- No shows will be turned out
- Cheating
- Smoking under covered areas, drinking, illegal drugs and foul language
- Quarreling or disputing with judges, committee persons or other contestants etc.
- Intentional abuse to livestock

### Payouts

- Payback will be 75% after stock charge
- 1-6 entries 100%
- 7-12 entries 60% 40%
- 13-18 entries 50% 30% 20%
- 19-24 entries 40% 30% 20% 10%
- 25-30 entries 30% 25% 20% 15% 10%
- 31 and up 29% 24% 19% 14% 9% 5%

### Points

1 <sup>st</sup> - 10	6 <sup>th</sup> - 5
2 <sup>nd</sup> - 9	7 <sup>th</sup> - 4
3 <sup>rd</sup> - 8	8 <sup>th</sup> - 3
4 <sup>th</sup> - 7	9 <sup>th</sup> - 2
5 <sup>th</sup> -6	10 <sup>th</sup> - 1

### Prizes

- **Peanuts- Grand Prize-** Overall points winner (1) boy and (1) girl  
**Buckles** awarded to winners of each event and all around  
**Money** will be awarded according to entries
- **Sub Jr., Jr., Sr.- Grand Prize-** will be awarded to overall points winner of the day boy or girl  
**Saddles-** will be awarded to boy and girl overall points winners not winning the grand prize. If overall winner of either gender wins the grand prize then the saddle goes to the second overall points winner of that gender, boy or girl.  
**Buckles** awarded to winners of each event and all around in each age division  
**Money** will be awarded according to entries

### **Tie Breaker**

- Buckles - will be a roll of the dice (high number wins)
- Money - will be split
- Saddle – will be how many 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nds and so on until the tie is broken
- Grand Prize – will be how many 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nds and so on until the tie is broken

### **Stock**

- Cutbacks and cripples stock will be culled before, during and after

### **Advancement**

- Contestants may compete up in age groups but will only be eligible for prizes and money- No points
- Rough stock- if no one makes the whistle in their event, the buckle will be awarded to the time closest to the whistle, NO money or points will be given.

Only 1 assistant per contestant will be allowed in arena at any given time

All rules and regulations as well as prizes are subject to change as deemed necessary by the youth rodeo committee.

All entries must be received by Sept. deadline- No late or day of rodeo entries accepted

All paperwork needed must be in by Sept. deadline, entries will not be accepted and refunds will not be made if paperwork is not received

Please read all rules before entering as there will be no refunds.

Should there be a state or county deemed necessary cancelation of this event all entry money will be refunded.
