Goat Tying

Goat Tying

- This event is for Sub Jr., Jr., and Sr.
- This is a live animal event
- Goat shall be staked at 105 feet from the starting line
- Time starts when the contestant crosses the timer line and stops when goat is tied and contestant calls for time
- Goat shall be staked with rope ten feet in length and goat holder (provided) must hold goat at full length of rope until the contestant steps off their animal, at this time holder will let go of the goat
- Contestant must be mounted on animal, heads towards the goat, dismounts, throws the goat by hand, and ties any three legs; the goat must remain tied for at least 5 seconds
- Goat will be changed after every 5 contestants; no shows will count towards a run when it comes to changing goats
- Goats will be changed at the beginning of each age division
- If the goat breaks loose at no fault of the contestant they will be granted a re-run per the discretion of the judge
- Judges will flag start and stop time. There will be two timekeepers.
- Contestant will be awarded a 10 second penalty if the horse steps on or crosses the rope after the contestant has dismounted.

Disqualification/No Time

- Contestant will receive a no time if their horse hits the goat or the goat rope while still mounted.
- If goat comes untied before allotted time

Re-Runs will be at the discretion of the judge. All ground rules must be followed.
