Barrier Event

Ribbon Roping

- This is a live animal event for Jr., Sr.
- One loop is permitted
- Catch as catch can
- No dragging calf
- Rope must be tied hard and fast
- Roper ropes the calf, dismounts and goes to animal, roper must have a mugger (anyone in the
 youth rodeo that day), mugger must have their hands on the calf before roper takes ribbon off,
 roper gets ribbon off the tail of the calf and runs back across the line
- Neck rope is to be used
- Horse must be moving out of the box to be a legal catch
- There will be two time keepers and judges
- Time starts when the barrier flag breaks and stops when field judge drops the flag
- 60 second time limit
- Back gate (let out) will remain open
- 10 second penalty will be added for breaking the barrier

Disqualification

- If roper fails to rope the calf
- Dropped or broken rope
- Not having a neck rope on horse
- Horse is not moving out of box when calf is roped
- If roper takes ribbon off before mugger touches calf
- If roper doesn't have the ribbon in hand when crossing back over line
- If roped in the let out gate
- Any abuse to livestock

Re-Run

If a rerun is given; at the discretion of the judge, any penalties incurred during original run will be added.

If the ribbon is not on or falls off the calf before the roper gets to it

All general rules must be followed
