## **Tie Down Calf Roping**

### **Barrier Event**

#### **Tie Down Calf Roping**

- This is a live animal event for Jr., Sr.
- One loop is permitted
- Catch as catch can
- No dragging calf
- Rope must be tied hard and fast
- Roper must dismount, go down the rope, throw the calf by hand and cross any three legs
- Jr. ropers may have assistance in throwing and/or clearing the calf but will have a 10 second penalty added
- If calf is jerked down, it must be picked up and clear daylight before throwing and tying
- If ropers hand is on the calf when calf falls, calf is considered thrown by hand
- Roper must ride up to give slack in rope to start the tie time, tie must hold until judge signals after 6 seconds, if the rope comes off, time will start when contestant steps away from calf
- Neck rope is to be used
- Horse must be moving out of the box to be a legal catch
- There will be two time keepers and judges
- Time starts when the barrier flag breaks and stops when field judge drops the flag
- 60 second time limit
- Back gate (let out) will remain open
- 10 second penalty will be added for breaking the barrier

#### **Disqualification**

- If roper fails to rope the calf
- Dropped or broken rope
- Not having a neck rope on horse
- Horse is not moving out of box when calf is roped
- If calf gets up or kicks loose before the 6 second time
- If roped in the let out gate
- Any abuse to livestock

#### **Re-Run**

If a rerun is given; at the discretion of the judge, any penalties incurred during original run will be added. All general rules must be followed
