Please accept the entries (property) described herein. The Fair Management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the exhibitors or exhibits at the Fair. The exhibitor (or parent or guardian of a minor) is responsible for any injury or damage resulting from the exhibitor's participation in the program or event. This includes any injury to others or to the exhibitor or to the exhibitor's property.

JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION

This is a terminal sale for all market animals, meaning all animals will be sold and processed for consumption.

CERTIFICATE OF ANIMAL MEDICATION

Every market animal exhibitor at the Tehama District Fair must complete this form prior to sale of animal at the Junior Livestock Auction. Animal will not be eligible to sell if this form is not signed. Under penalty of perjury, we certify that:

1.) No unauthorized chemicals have been used which would cause the carcass to fail USDA and Food & Drug Administration Standards.

2.) The withdrawal time required of any medication (including medicated feed), fungicide, or pesticide administered has been adhered to.

As the owner of this Market Animal, I acknowledge I will be responsible for my animal if it is rejected at a processing center due to the presence of drug residues. If drug residue is detected I may be liable to the Buyer for an amount equal to three times the purchase price and may also be liable for attorney's fees and civil penalties (Food and Agriculture Code Section 14363).

WFA YOUTH EXHIBITOR CODE OF PRACTICE

As a youth participant at Tehama District Fair:

I believe my participation in the youth program should demonstrate my own ability, knowledge, and skill, and my own investment of time in my project I am exhibiting. I will do my own work and accept only advice and support from others.

I will also not allow my parents, advisor, supervisor/leader, or any other adult or minor to employ such practices to my project.

I realize I am responsible for:

- The proper care and treatment of my project.
- The presentation of my exhibit at the Fair.
- The production of wholesome food, fiber, clothing, and textiles.
- The development of sound moral character in myself and others.

I understand that when my parents, my supervisor/leader, or any other adult or minor connected with my project break the rules, I must live by the decision of the Fair Management.
