Texas Renaissance Festival Grounds Selected as Bike MS: Texas MS 150 Start

February 24, 2021 (Todd Mission, TX) – The Texas Renaissance Festival is pleased to announce that the festival grounds has been selected as one of the start locations for this year’s Bike MS: Texas MS 150 that will be held on Saturday, May 1. The TRF rolling start will begin at 8:30 a.m. The route from Todd Mission is 68 miles that will travel through Grimes County and finish at the 50-yard line at Kyle Field in College Station.

“As the Texas MS 150 organizers are striving to hold a safe and socially distant ride this year, we were honored that the festival grounds were selected as one of the start locations for this year’s ride,” said Pat Coveney TRF General Manager.

In addition to utilizing the TRF grounds for parking and start staging, the King and Queen of the festival and TRF Ambassadors will be on hand to greet riders and send them off at the start line. Funds raised from Bike MS fund services and research aimed at helping those who are affected by MS.

Bike MS: Texas MS 150 is more than a ride. It's an experience grounded in camaraderie and marked by passion, inspiration, determination and pure enjoyment. It will be an experience you'll never forget.

The Texas MS 150 will be hosted as a one-day, in-person experience in order for us provide the safest experience possible, with four start locations, fully supported routes and an iconic finish on Kyle Field at Texas A&M University.
