To **reserve land**, please attach the following informational documents:

- Location of the land you are requesting (drawn on provided map)
- Detailed proposed layout with dimensions (hand-drawn is acceptable)
 - You may not request more than 600 square feet per Season Pass Holder. All Season Passes must be purchased by September 7th, or your plot size will be reduced accordingly.
 - To dedicate land towards a Guild, each Season Pass holder must complete and submit a [2026 Guild Commitment Form](#).
- List of large items that will remain in campsite (# of RVs w/length, # of Vehicle w/type, # of Tents w/size, Temporary Construction Builds, Trailers (Hitch/Travel/Equipment))
- Move out will be held 11/30-12/6 during operations hours of 9am-4pm. Final move out day **12/6** will operate **9am-12pm**. **Plan accordingly.**

TRF Campgrounds Director will review the plans and approve or disapprove the site location, size, and materials used.

'26 Site Rules and Requirements

- Entrance to the campground is ONLY permitted through the main gate off CR 302 (Finke Rd)
- No permanent structures.
- No permanent changes to the natural landscape.
- Everything constructed (buildings, stages, boundaries, etc.) must be temporary.
- Temporary structures and boundaries must be removed at the season's end. No ground installations are permitted of any kind.
- The Texas Renaissance Festival assumes no liability for any damages, injuries, or losses resulting from the use or misuse of any construction.
- All boundaries must be at least 10 feet off any Roadway and no shorter than 4 feet tall.
- Any boundaries or structures, no matter how small or large, must be preapproved by TRF management.
- TRF Management must be able to visit any gathering space to ensure safety measures are being met.
- TRF reserves the right to remove any structure or boundaries at any time, with or without notice.
- Patrons are responsible for all trash within their campsite.
- All trash must be deposited in a dumpster by the end of each weekend.
- Labor to remove any structures/trash may be charged to the individual and/or Guild Representative (e.g. chairs, rope, coolers, tent stakes, tie-down anchors, firewood/ash, or any non-organic/organic items used for a boundary). Pack it in; pack it out.

Do not enter the campgrounds without contacting the TRF Campground Staff for approval.
