### 2023 DRAFT HORSE SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

### **ENTRIES:**

All entries must be postmarked by September 4, 2023.

CAMPERS: \*TAKE NOTE\* ALL CAMPER RESERVATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES. CAMPERS MUST BE ORDERED THROUGH HORSESHOWSONLINE.COM OR ON THE OFFICIAL ESE ENTRY BLANK WITH PAYMENT. IF MAILING PAPER ENTRIES, THEY MUST BE POST MARKED NO LATER THAN THE CLOSING DATE WITH A TRACKING NUMBER. IF CAMPERS ARE NOT ORDERED IN EITHER OF THESE MANNERS, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN A SPOT. ANY DISREGARD FOR THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE GROUNDS. IF CAMPER SPOTS ARE AVAILABLE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE, THEY MAY BE ORDERED WITH A \$25 PER SPOT LATE FEE.

Camper spots are \$200/week. Space is limited to exhibitors showing at the ESE Horse Show. Campers are limited to two (2) per hitch. No cars or trucks are allowed to be parked in camper lot. All other camper cars may park in the VIP lot. Enter Gate 1 (westernmost Gate) on Memorial Avenue, Route 147. Camper parking will be at the direction of the camper lot attendant. If space is not available in the Horse Show area, camping is available at Gate 9 on a "first come, first served" basis without reservations, hook-ups, or electricity. Campers may arrive on Monday, September 25th after 3:30 pm. Campers should be out by 5:00 pm Sunday, October 1st.

### PAYMENT:

All fees (entry fees, stall fees, camper fees, etc.) must accompany entry blank or entries will be returned to sender. Payment must be made in U.S. funds payable to Eastern States Exposition. **NO REFUNDS!** A penalty of fifty dollars (\$50) will be charged for returned checks. Returned checks must be replaced by cash or certified funds. Stall fees are non-refundable.

### STABLING:

Stalls with asphalt floors will be available for a fee of \$50 per stall. Bedding may be purchased in advance and will be at your stalls when you arrive. Please pre-order feed and bedding online prior to arrival at <a href="TheBigE.com/agriculture">TheBigE.com/agriculture</a>. Phone in orders at 413-205-5307. Please indicate your estimated arrival time when placing your order. An open check or credit card will be required. Bedding must be ordered in advance if you plan to arrive later than 5:00 p.m.

### ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

Horses may arrive after noon, Tuesday, September 26th. Please be sure to indicate the anticipated arrival time and date on the entry form. Horses must be removed from grounds by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, October 2nd, unless prior approval is obtained from management. All exhibitors must settle accounts and obtain a release before the start of the last session of the show and before removing equipment and horses from the grounds.

### GATE ADMISSION POLICY:

Wristbands are good for daily admission to the grounds and unlimited access to and from the stabling area and Coliseum. Upon receipt and payment in full of your entry, wristbands and parking passes will be mailed with your acknowledgment. Wristbands will be provided complimentary, based on the number of horses in your stable. 1 horse = 2 wristbands, 2 horses = 3 wristbands, 3 horses = 4 wristbands, 4 horses or more = 5 wristbands. Additional exhibitor wristbands may be purchased at the Horse Show Office for \$20 each. No refunds!! NOTE: It is important that your correct mailing address appears clearly on the entry blank in order to assure timely delivery of admission credentials.

### VAN AND TRAILER SATELLITE PARKING:

**Please Note** - Due to limited space, vans and trailers must be parked off grounds in the auxiliary parking area at no cost to exhibitors. Directions to the satellite parking area will be available online at TheBigE. com/horseshow. A map and directions will be mailed with admission credentials in September. There is no vehicle parking in the camper lot.

### PREMIUMS:

All premium money will be paid within 30 days of close of the show to the listed hitch owner/recipient of prize money listed on entry. Valid social security number or EIN must be provided. A 1099 will be issued for any winnings over \$600, regardless of whether or not premium money is applied to show invoice balance.

### POST ENTRIES:

Post entries will be accepted provided stalls are available at an additional fee of \$5 per class.

### NOTICE:

Eastern States Exposition Draft Horse Show is held in conjunction with all laws and regulations of the United States and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and all exhibitors are notified to comply therewith special reference to Horse Protection Act of 1970 as amended.

### RESERVATIONS:

Management reserves the right to (a) add or cancel a class, (b) decline or refuse any entry, (c) eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or horse should the best interests of the show be served.

### RESPONSIBILITY:

Neither Eastern States Exposition, its management, employees or independent contractors will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that is lost, destroyed or stolen, nor liable for any injury sustained to horses, exhibitors, spectators or employees. Under Massachusetts law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 128, Section 2D of the General Laws.

### MEDICAL WASTE:

Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management.

### FIRE & SAFETY REGULATIONS:

The following regulations must be adhered to in accordance with the Town of West Springfield Fire Regulations and Public Safety Code:

- a. No smoking allowed in barns or Coliseum.
- b. No open flames allowed in any barn or building.
- c. Fireproof material must be used for all stall decorations. Exhibitors must have an affidavit stating that tack and stall curtains have been flameproofed with DuPont MX12 or its equivalent during the past year. If tack and stall curtains are permanently flameproofed, bring affidavit stating so.
- d. The center aisle of C and E Barns must remain clear. Tack stall decorations must not extend more than 18" into the aisle. All aisles must have a walkway free of floor obstructions.
- e. Bedding material may not be allowed on the floor of any aisle for display purposes. This includes wood shavings, wood sawdust and peat moss. Large wood chips or coarse bark mulch may be used and must be kept damp at all times. The use of burlap for display purposes is strictly prohibited.
- f. Coverings over the aisles which would in any way limit the effectiveness of the sprinkler system will not be allowed.

### **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:**

Scooters, golf carts or other motorized vehicles will not be allowed to operate on the fairgrounds from 8:00 a.m. through closing of the Fair at 10:00 p.m. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

### JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:

Drivers under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult capable of driving.

#### DOGS:

Due to the *No Pet Policy* on the fairgrounds, dogs of horse show exhibitors *are restricted to the stabling* area of the Horse Show complex. Dogs are not allowed in the Coliseum, entertainment staging areas or out along the parade route. Dogs must be restrained by a leash and will not be permitted to be tied to a barn aisle. Exhibitors will be expected to clean up after their dogs, especially in the areas adjacent to campers and food service facilities. This rule will be strictly enforced with a fine of \$200 imposed to anyone in violation. Dogs are subject to Massachusetts Animal Health Regulations.

Upon signing of entry the exhibitor grants permission to be photographed/interviewed by the Exposition in connection with the activity. All photographs/video are the property of the Exposition and may be used for their purposes.

### ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS:

- a. All equines entering a Massachusetts fairground must have a valid health certificate. Note: The Big E Fairgrounds in West Springfield requires a CVI issued within the prior 30 days for all equines entering the premises for any show, fair, or exhibition.
- b. All equines originating from within and outside of the Commonwealth must have a negative USDA approved EIA test (i.e., Coggins test or ELISA test) dated within twelve months of entry.
- c. Evidence of infectious, contagious or parasitic disease or failure to produce the necessary documents for health certification, vaccination or testing will result in the animal's rejection for entry. **THE INSPECTOR'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
- d. All equines must be free of visual evidence of the following diseases and conditions: mange, ringworm, soring, strangles, and open or draining wounds.
- e. While not required, it is strongly recommended that all equines be vaccinated for rabies, tetanus, EEE and WNV within one year of the fair.
- f. All health papers will be examined and must be in order.
- g. All horses with a cough or diarrhea will be examined by a show veterinarian in order to remain on the show grounds.
- h. A quarantine area will be set up for all horses that should be in it.
- i. The show veterinarian will document all horses examined and the reason that they were examined and without specific names publish it on an ESE website.
- The show veterinarian will document all potentially sick horses and provide that information to Massachusetts Department of Animal Health.
- k. It is recommended that all horses exhibited at ESE should be vaccinated within the past six months for respiratory infection.

Any surgical procedure or injection of any foreign substance or drug or the external application of any substance (irritant, counterirritant, or similar substance) which could affect the animal's performance or alter its natural contour, conformation or appearance, except external applications of substances to the hoofs or horns of animals which affect appearance only, and except for surgical procedures performed by a duly licensed veterinarian for the sole purpose of protecting the health of the animal, is prohibited.

Eastern States Exposition Horse Shows follow the IAFE Code of Conduct. ESE has the right to remove any exhibitor/attendee that is not in compliance with the Code.
