Division 6501 Recycled or Repurposed Craft

Create a usable item from materials that have been repurposed or recycled.

RULES

- 1. The item must be altered to serve a purpose other than its original use.
- 2. The piece must be constructed from at least 90% recycled materials.
- 3. Paint and components used to fasten or adhere parts (such as glue or screws) are not required to be recycled.
- 4. You must include a card with your submission that lists the materials you used and what components are recycled.
- 5. Items should measure no more than 18 inches high, 18 inches wide, and 18 inches deep and must weigh no more than 10 lbs.



- 6. Entered items will be accepted at the New England Center from 8:30 am until 12:00 noon on the day of the contest and must remain on display until 6:00 pm, unless selected for Best of Department.
- 7. Entered items must be set up for judging by 12:30 pm.
- 8. Entered items may be mailed in advance to be received a minimum of 7 days prior to the contest. Insurance is recommended. Please include our shipping form with your mailed in entry. Mail to:

- 9. Eastern States Exposition, contest promoters and/or donors are not responsible for late, incomplete, or misdirected entries.
- 10. Entries may be photographed and used by show donors for promotional purposes; the photos become the property of The Big E.
- 11. The New England Center is a non-profit building where Agriculture and Education take precedence over sales. No sales are allowed within the building.
- 12. Entered items delivered by hand may be picked up from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm the day of the contest, except Best of Department items will remain on display for the remainder of the fair and may be picked up on October 2 from 12:00 pm to 7:00 pm or October 3 from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. that were mailed in may be returned in the same manner with prepaid postage and insurance provided by the exhibitor.

- a. Entries that are not awarded Best of Department are not guaranteed to be displayed due to space constraints.
- 13. All entered items submitted must have been completed within the last 3 (three) years and not have been exhibited at The Big E in prior years.
- 14. An exhibitor may submit a total of up to three (3) entries. All entries must be included on one exhibitor entry form.
- 15. Entries must be submitted with exhibitor's name, address, and phone number.
- 16. An instructor/professional is an individual who grosses more than \$2,000 per year from their craft, whether in sales or teaching. Youth are 5-18 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
- 17. With entry submission, you accept all contest rules and agree to be bound by the judges' decisions, which will be final.
- 18. Taxes are the responsibility of the winner.

- -Contains 90% recycled materials
- -Workmanship
- -Durability
- -Aesthetics
- -Usefulness
