SPECIAL RULES

1. Read General Rules: All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.

2. Eligibility: All animals entered in the American Aberdeen Show are subject to the provisions of the American Aberdeen Registry.

3. Identification: All eligible animals must have a legible tattoo to participate in this show.

4. Premier Breeder & Exhibitor: Premier Breeder will be awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals bred by him/her and shown in individual classes. Premier Exhibitor **will be** awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals (not to exceed 10) exhibited by him/her in individual classes.

Point Tabulation: The highest number of points allowed per class will equal one less than the number of animals in the class (10 shown 1st gets 9 points, 2nd gets 8, etc.)

- a. Class with only one animal will not receive any points.
- b. Points will be given for Divisional Champions & Reserve Champions – equaling the number of classes represented (Cow/Calf and Steer are considered a division) – i.e., 3 classes = 3 points for Division Champion, 2 points for Reserve.
- c. No points for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female or Bull or group classes.
- d. Animals owned jointly will be considered separate exhibitors in Premier Exhibitor tabulations. Leased animals will be considered an entry of the Lessee.
- e. To be eligible for Premier Breeder the breeder must be an exhibitor in the current show.
- f. In the event of a tie the number of points shall be divided by the number of animals the points were derived from and the exhibitor/breeder having the higher point average shall be presented the award.

5. Herdsman: ESE will award a Herdsman's show stick to the American Aberdeen exhibitor showing consideration to fellow exhibitors and management representing his/her cattle and farm to the public in a positive manner as determined by the Beef Show Superintendent.

6. Group Entries: Group classes may be entered on the original entry form or may be entered during check-in, no entry fee required. Each animal must be entered into an Open Show individual class and check in at the ring; the exception is the Cow-Calf class.

7. Proof of Ownership: The entry's original registration certificate, online paper or association duplicate (NO PHOTOCOPIES) will be considered as proof of ownership, identity, age and breeder. The ownership listed on the entry must correlate with ownership listed on the registration certificate. Animals under one year of age may show a copy of the registration application statement from the breed association stating animal registration is pending.

8. Exhibitor: The exhibitor must be the owner or member of a partnership or syndicate owning the animal. Animals owned in partnership or syndicates must be entered and shown in an individual class of the show under the partnership or syndicate's name. In group classes, partnership or syndicate animals may be entered and exhibited under the name of one of the co-owners but must be entered in all group classes in the same manner. For meeting the requirements in all group classes and for Premier Breeder and Exhibitor, an exhibitor is further defined as those members of an immediate family residing on one farm and where the herd is one unit.

9. Substitution: Any entry may be substituted within or between classes after the entry deadline, providing the owner and/or part owner making the original entry is owner and/or part owner of the entry being substituted. A registration number assigned by the breed association and accompanied by a letter from the breed will be acceptable. Substitutions may be made among different members of the same family on the same farm.

10. Steer Classes: Steers must have registration papers. Steers will be divided equally into weight classes after weigh-in. If total animals cannot be divided evenly, the larger class would first be prospects, then lightweight, etc. Weighing will be on arrival, following health inspection.

11. Fullblood vs Percentage: Only 50% Aberdeen or greater may compete in the percentage show.

12. Classes: Any of the classes may be split if the classes become too large, or classes may be combined within a division at the discretion of show management.

13. Cow-Calf: All females shown in Cow-Calf class with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. All females born before August 31, 2023, must be shown with calf at side. All females born September 1, 2023, through April 30, 2023, must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1.) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or 2.) females shown with calf at side.

14. Show Order: Show order will be as in the show catalog.

15. Tie Outs: Show management reserves the right to assign tie-outs prior to arrival.

JUNIOR SPECIAL RULES

1. Exhibitors must be 21 years old as of January 1, 2025, or under and over the age of 5 as of the first of the year and must have animals entered in the American Aberdeen Show.

2. Exhibitors must fill out a Junior Beef Show entry form in addition to the Open Show form.

3. A junior's name must be on the registration as owned or co-owned. Leased animals will be accepted if dated on or before September 1, 2025. 4-H Leases will be accepted. The Junior Show will be a combined owned and leased show.

4. Heifers in the Junior Show will be born October 31, 2023, and after. There will be no bulls or group classes.

5. All Junior Exhibitors will step forward during Open Show classes for junior placings to be awarded and received. A Champion Female and Reserve Champion Female Percentage and Fullblood owned/shown by a junior exhibitor will be awarded.

6. Showmanship: Showmanship will be comprised of four showmanship classes. Showmanship classes will be determined after entries have been processed. Showmanship participants must be signed up by the end of check-in. Day of show sign-ups will not be permitted.

7. Premiums: Allocated premium money not used in Aberdeen classes will be used to provide a bonus up to \$25.00 per head owned by Junior Exhibitors

The junior members' last year of eligibility is the calendar year of their 21st birthday. Membership in 4-H, FFA, or any other agricultural youth organization is not a requirement to show. Animals must be registered in the American Angus Association in the exhibitor's name before August 15, 2025. 4-H leases will be accepted if dated June 1, 2025. Animals registered in farm, family names, or syndicates are ineligible to show in the Junior Show. Bull calves and Cow-Calf classes must be bred and owned for Junior Recognition.
- 3.** All Junior exhibitors will abide by regulations as to entry, stabling, health, etc. Junior exhibitors may show in the Open Show. An animal entered in a Junior's name and shown in the Junior Show must be shown in that exhibitor's name in the Open Show. Junior shown animals will pull ahead for placing at the conclusion of the class. Junior animals are eligible to show in heifer classes 705-723, Bull classes 728-732 and Cow-Calf classes 701 and 702.

- d. Animals owned jointly will be considered separate exhibitors in Premier Exhibitor tabulations. Leased animals will be considered an entry of the Lessee.
- e. To be eligible for Premier Breeder the breeder must be an exhibitor in the current show.
- f. In the event of a tie the number of points shall be divided by the number of animals the points were derived from and the exhibitor/breeder having the higher point average shall be presented the award.

4. Herdsman: ESE will award a Herdsman's show stick to the Belted Galloway exhibitor showing consideration to fellow exhibitors and Management representing his/her cattle and farm to the public in a positive manner as determined by the Beef Show Superintendent.

5. Steer Classes: Steers must have a Society Paper of Recordation. Steers will be divided equally into weight classes after weigh-in. If total animals cannot be divided evenly, the larger class would first be Prospects, then Lightweight, etc. Weigh-in will be available on arrival, following health inspection.

6. Any heifer with a calf at the side will go into Cow-Calf A.

7. Lease information: To comply with recent action taken by U.S. Belted Galloway Society:

A lease agreement must be on file with the CLRC by July 1, 2025 for animals to be shown under the lessee's name.

- a. Exhibitor Points will be awarded to the Lessee of the animal.

SPECIAL RULES

- 1. Read General Rules:** All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.
- 2.** If there is no show for any one breed, they will be grouped into this "Other Beef Breeds" class. If a breed show is available for a specific breed, the animal must compete in the breed show and cannot compete in ORB.
- 3.** All animals must be registered with their respective National Breed Associations.
- 4. Show Management** may combine or divide given classes at their discretion for the best exhibition. No special classes or classes beyond the ages given will be added. Breeds may be separated based on entry numbers.
- 5. Premier Breeder:** Awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals bred by him/her and shown in the individual classes.
- Premier Exhibitor:** Awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals (not to exceed 10) exhibited by him/her in individual classes.
- Point Tabulation:** The highest amount of points allowed per class will equal one less than the number of animals in the class (10 shown first gets 9 points, 2nd gets 8 etc.)
 - a. Class with only one animal will not receive any points.
 - b. Points will be given for Divisional Champions & Reserve Champions – equaling the number of classes represented (Cow/Calf and Steer are considered a division), i.e., 3 classes = 3 points for Division Champion, 2 points for Reserve.
 - c. No points for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female or Bull or group classes.
 - d. Animals owned jointly will be considered a separate exhibitor in Premier Exhibitor tabulations. Leased animals will be considered an entry of the Lessee.
 - e. To be eligible for Premier Breeder the breeder must be an exhibitor in the current show.
 - f. In the event of a tie the number of points shall be divided by the number of animals the points were derived from and the exhibitor/breeder having the higher point average shall be presented the award.
- 6. Tie Outs:** Show management reserves the right to assign tie-outs prior to arrival.

JUNIOR RULES

1. Exhibitors must fill out Junior Beef Show Entry form in addition to Open Show form.
2. Junior's name must be on the registration as owned or co-owned. 4-H leased animals will be accepted if dated by June 1, 2025. The Junior Show will be a combined owned and leased show.
3. The Junior Show is heifers only. Animals will be born between September 1, 2023 and June 1, 2025.
4. All Junior Exhibitors will step forward during open show classes for Junior Placings to be awarded and received. A Champion Female and Reserve Champion Female owned/shown by a Junior exhibitor will be awarded. If more than 50 head are entered in the Junior Show a separate event will be held.
5. **Premiums:** Allocated premium money not used in ORB classes will be used to provide a bonus up to \$25.00 per head owned by Junior Exhibitors
