

Veterinary Science CDE: Eastern States Exposition

* The Veterinary Science CDE will follow the National FFA Rules and Event Procedures as posted on the National FFA website. Please utilize this resource for items to bring, resources, scorecards, and identification lists.

*Students will be in official dress for the entirety of the event.

Event Format:

- 1) Written Exam – 50 questions – 30 minutes
- 2) Identification - Equipment – 25 items, Parasites – 15 items, Breeds – 10 items – 30 minutes
- 3) Math Application Practicum – 30 minutes
- 4) Handling and Restraining Practicum (1) – **Will be one of the following three practicums; the exact one will be announced on the day of the contest:** removal of a cat from a cage and placing in a cat bag, restraint of a rabbit, placing a tail tie.
- 6) Clinical Procedure Practicum (1) – **Will be one of the following three practicums; the exact one will be announced on the day of the contest:** Applying aural medication, Filling a syringe, Removal of sutures.
- 7) Team Activity – **10 Minutes to Prepare, 10 minutes to Present, 5 Minutes for questions**
