BRAD PAISLEY TO COUNTRIFY THE BIG E ARENA, SEPT. 25
Tickets on Sale this Friday, May 15

Grammy-winning Country music superstar Brad Paisley has just released new music as part of an ongoing project titled *Tacklebox*. In addition to the release of his new track “Fallin’,” he announces dates for his Brad Paisley Live tour, including Friday, Sept. 25, when he performs in The Big E Arena, *sponsored by Truly Hard Seltzer*. Tickets, which include Fair admission for the concert day, go on sale Friday, May 15, at 10am EST at TheBigE.com.

Music Corporation of America (MCA) recording artist Brad Paisley has earned his place in Country music history as one of the genre’s most talented and decorated male solo artists. For nearly 25 years, his songwriting and unmatched showmanship have earned him numerous awards, including three Grammys, two American Music Awards (AMA), 15 Academy of Country Music Awards and 14 Country Music Association (CMA) Awards, including a highly coveted Entertainer of the Year honor and recognition as the most successful CMA Award co-host in history, alongside Carrie Underwood, for 11 consecutive years.

Paisley has been a member of the Grand Ole Opry since 2001, and he has written 21 of his 25 No. 1 hits. In 2008, he became the first artist to achieve 10 consecutive Billboard Country Airplay No. 1 singles. The superstar’s past works have amassed nearly 5 billion career streams, and Paisley was recently inducted into Nashville’s Songwriters Hall of Fame.

A portion of the new music heard in *Tacklebox* comes from his extensive catalog of unreleased and unrecorded songs, dating back to the 1990s, when his career began. Other songs were recently written and inspired by that same style as well as the unmistakable sounds of Alan Jackson, Brooks and Dunn and Alabama, as well as 80s-influenced productions derivative of George Strait, Garth Brooks and more. The first song, “Fallin’,” is available [across digital platforms](#) now.

Additional music from *Tacklebox* will be released soon, so keep a close eye on Paisley’s social media channels for up-to-date information.

Paisley also plans to perform a pivotal song from his catalog, “I’m Gonna Miss Her,” with *American Idol* contestant Lucas Leon during the show’s finale on Monday, May 11, at 8pm on ABC, live on Disney+ or available next day on Hulu. He first wrote the song in 1995 during his senior year at Belmont University in Nashville, Tenn., for his senior showcase. It became his third No. 1 single in 2002, bringing his career total to 25 No. 1 songs.
