



General Rules & Regulations

Entry Deadline: April 17, 2026
Show: May 1-3, 2026

- 1. Entry Deadline & Fees:** Entries are due by April 17, 2026. Late entries (available at check-in) incur an additional \$10 per head.
- 2. Steers and Market Heifers** will ALL be shown by weight. Classes will be broken based on numbers at the discretion of show management. There will be NO overall Market Animal Champion.
- 3. Market Heifers:** Heifers may NOT be cross-entered between the Jackpot Breeding and Jackpot Market Heifer divisions, nor between the Youth Breeding and Youth Market Heifer divisions.
- 4. Registration Papers:** Required for all heifers not entered in the crossbred division. Heifers will show by breed then by age.
 - a) If you are showing registered cattle, you must specify the registered breed on the entry.
 - b) Dual registered animals must designate which breed they will be showing at the time of entry.
- 5. Breeds with at least 4 entries** will have their own division, otherwise will show in the ORB division.
 - a) National breed association requirements will be enforced when dividing classes. If the national association mandates separate divisions for percentage and fullblood animals, each must meet the minimum requirement to form its own division.
 - b) If someone wishes to have a breed represented WITHOUT 4 head, they may sponsor the division for \$150.
- 6. Stalling:** Exhibitors are encouraged to show off their trailers. The location of trailers to be determined by show management at time of arrival. Exhibitors showing off their trailer must clean up all bedding before departure. Stalls will be assigned in the Mallary Complex, if requested.
- 7. Tie-Outs:** Tie-Outs are provided by the fairgrounds and will be available on a first-come first-served basis.
- 8. Feed and Bedding:** Initial bedding will be provided for those stalling in the Mallary Complex. Exhibitors will need to supply their own bedding for the tie-out area. Straw, shavings and feed will be available for purchase.
- 9. Camping:** Spots are available for \$25 per night. No reservation is required—payment is due upon arrival to Gate 1.
- 10. Health Requirements:** All animals entering the show grounds must comply with Massachusetts and national animal health regulations. Exhibitors are required to present an official health certificate, issued by a licensed veterinarian dated January 1, 2026, or later.

Any animal showing signs of illness, including but not limited to fever, open wounds, coughing, nasal discharge, ringworm, or warts, may be dismissed from the premises at the discretion of the show officials and/or an on-site health inspector. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and well-being of their animals throughout the event. Failure to comply with these health rules may result in disqualification.
- 11. The Eastern States Exposition Showring Policy and Code of Ethics** applies to all participants. To view the complete policy, visit: [Showring Policy and Code of Ethics](#).
- 12. Release:** Exhibitors may leave upon completion of their showing.
- 13. Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- 14. Scooters:** Any use of personalized wheeled vehicles, apart from mobility scooters in the barn, shall be subject to fine. This includes, but is not limited to, anything that an individual can ride (e.g., bicycle, hoverboard, action scooter, or similar wheeled vehicles.)



Jackpot & Youth Show Rules & Regulations

Entry Deadline: April 17, 2026
Show: May 1-3, 2026

Jackpot Rules

- 1. General Rules:** Review the General Rules and Regulations. These rules and regulations will apply in the jackpot heifer and steer shows.
- 2. Entry Deadline & Fees:** Entries are due by April 17, 2026, with a \$45 fee per entry. Late entries (available at check-in) incur an additional \$10 per head.
- 3. Age of Participants:** Open to exhibitors of all ages.
- 4. Check-In:** Check-in begins at 12:00 noon on Thursday, April 31, 2026. **All Jackpot animals must be checked in by 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 2, 2026.** Upon arrival, please have health papers and registration papers ready for inspection. If arriving outside of scheduled check-in times, exhibitors must call 413-205-5011 before unloading any animals.
- 5. Weigh-In:** The official weigh-in for steers and market heifers will take place on Friday at 11 a.m. Animals arriving on Saturday morning will be weighed at check-in, directly off the trailer.
- 6. Jackpot Premiums:** Top 5 places in each of the jackpot shows will receive a payout. Overall payout will be determined at the show.

Youth Rules

- 1. General Rules:** Review the General Rules and Regulations. These rules and regulations will apply in the youth heifer and steer shows.
- 2. Entry Deadline & Fees:** Entries are due by April 17, 2026, with a \$35 fee per entry. Registered Hereford steers will incur an additional \$35 entry fee to show in the Regional Hereford steer show. Late entries (available at check-in) incur an additional \$10 per head.
- 3. Age of Participants:** Open to all exhibitors ages 5-21 as of January 1, 2026.
- 4. Check-In:** Check-in begins at 12:00 noon on Thursday, May 1, 2026. All Youth animals must be checked in by 12:00 noon on Friday, May 2, 2025. Upon arrival, please have health papers and registration papers ready for inspection.
- 5. Weigh-In:** The official weigh-in for steers and market heifers will take place on Friday afternoon at 11 a.m.
- 6. Registration papers or leases in the name of the junior exhibiting are required for all heifers not entered in the crossbred division. Heifers will show by breed then by age.**
- 7. Showmanship:** Showmanship will be blow n' go. A Top Five Overall will be selected, along with a Top Five in each of the following divisions, except for Peewee:
 - Peewee: Ages 5-8 (Top Five does not apply)
 - Junior: Ages 9-12
 - Intermediate: Ages 13-16
 - Senior: Ages 17-21Call backs for Top Five Overall Showman will be at the discretion of the judge and/or show management.
- 8. Hereford Eligibility & Requirements:** All Herefords must be owned solely by the youth exhibitor or jointly with a sibling to be eligible for the Hereford Regional Junior Show. A minimum of 30 days of ownership is required. Tattoos that are missing, illegible, altered, incorrect, or otherwise inconsistent with official American Hereford Association (AHA) records may result in disqualification at the discretion of the designated AHA official.
 - a. Hereford Youth Steers:** Hereford youth steers must have steer registration papers from the AHA to qualify for the Regional status of the Hereford Show. Additionally, Hereford steers must have a valid DNA profile on file with the AHA. Exhibitors are required to present an official letter from the AHA confirming their steer's DNA profile, along with the steer's registration paper, at check-in. Hereford steers may also enter the Youth Market Animal Show by paying double the entry fee. On the entry form, please indicate that the animal is entered in the Hereford Steer class.
