

2021 Big East Rules & Regulations

April 30-May 1, 2021

ENTRY DEADLINE: APRIL 23, 2021 Contact: 413-205-5009 or bigeast@thebige.com

- 1. Entry Deadline: April 23, 2021. Late entries will be accepted until show time for an additional \$10 per show.
- 2. Age of Participants: The Jackpot Show is open to exhibitors of all ages. The Youth show is for juniors who are 3 years old as of January 1, 2021 and not older than 23 years as of January 1, 2021.
- 3. Tie-Outs: Tie-Outs are provided by the fairgrounds. You will need to supply your own bedding for the tie-out area. Straw and shavings will be available for purchase at the show.
- 4. Stalling: Stalls will be assigned in the Mallary Complex, if desired. Please see posted stall plans around the barn. Initial Bark mulch bedding will be provided. **NEW** Exhibitors are encouraged to show off trailers. *Location of trailers to be determined by show management at arrival. Must clean up all bedding before departure.
- 5. Health Requirements: We will not accept animals with RINGWORM or WARTS. Health certificates (CVI) must be dated January 1, 2021 or later. For a complete list of Massachusetts health requirements, please go to: https://www.mass.gov/doc/agricultural-fairs-animal-health-rules/download. RFID TAGS REQUIRED.
- 6. All Purebred cattle showing in the Youth Show must have registration certificates or leases in the name of the junior exhibiting. All Herefords need to be owned by either the youth or in the youth and siblings name only, in order to be shown in the Hereford Regional Junior Show. Not less than 30 day ownership. All Hereford tattoos will be checked. Tattoos which in the opinion of the designated AHA official are found to be missing, illegible, altered, incorrect, and/or in any other way in disagreement with the official AHA records might be disqualified.
- 7. Simmental Show: All Simmentals in the Simmental Show must be registered as 100% Simmental. A percentage show will be offered if show requirements are met.
- 8. American Aberdeen: 50% to 99% registered Aberdeens are to be entered in the Aberdeen Percentage Show. 100% registered Aberdeens are to be entered in the Aberdeen Fullblood Show.
- 9. Breeds with at least 6 entries will have their own division. Otherwise they will show in the AOB division.
- 10. The Eastern States Exposition Showring Policy and Code of Ethics will apply. For a complete copy, please go to: http://d2w7gersd1ix5b.cloudfront.net/files.ashx?t=fg&f=15showringcodeethics.pdf&rid=TheBigE
- 11. Heifers may enter Market Heifer show with double entry fee. Youth Steers and market heifers will be shown by weight. Heifers may be cross entered into the Market Heifer Show, if doing so double entry fees must be paid. Market heifers will be shown by weight.
- 12. Hereford Youth steers need to have steer registration papers from the American Hereford Association as a requirement of the Regional status of the Hereford Show. On the entry form, please make sure you denote that this animal is to show in the Hereford Steer class. Please make sure the animals are correctly tattooed and their tattoo is legible. Hereford steers are required to have a correct DNA profile on file with the American Hereford Association (AHA). Hereford steer exhibitors are required to present the letter from the AHA stating their steer's DNA profile is on file with the AHA along with their steer's registration paper at check-in
- 13. Check-In: All animals must be checked in by 7am Saturday, May 1, 2021. Check-In begins at 12noon Friday, April 30, 2021. Upon arrival please be prepared to present health papers and registration papers. ALL steers and market heifers will be weighed at this time.
- 14. Any exhibitor may leave when done showing.-Exhibitors are welcome to spend the night on Saturday in tie out.
- 15. Showmanship: Showmanship will be blow n' go.
- 16. Dogs and Scooters: All dogs must be on a leash at all times. Scooters may be used in designated outside areas only.
- 17. All COVID regulations are required to be followed and masks MUST be worn during the entire event.
