General Description:

This includes assisting with the planning and implementation of the 2024 Erie County Fair marketing plan, social media content development, engaging in excellent guest service and more!

Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist with the execution of the 2024 Erie County Fair Marketing Plan.
- 2. Research social media and graphic design trends and identify opportunities to create content that aligns with those trends.
- 3. Develop and execute social media content across social channels.

4. Assist with website edits and content creation for ecfair.org, the-fairgrounds.com as well as the Fairgrounds mobile app.

- 5. Assist with creation of print and digital marketing materials.
- 6. Assist with special event planning and media relations.
- 7. Overall support of the Marketing Department.

- Knowledge and experience with Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign).
